JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound during which they clashed with several residents. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu until 14:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Anata. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma ’ale Adumim for Sabbath Holiday.

<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Ein Yabrud bridge. (ii) At 16:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge until 17:10. (iii) At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Um Safa village until 19:40. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazun camp fired rubber coated steel, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 22:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazun camp opened fire towards the camp for alleged gun fire towards “Bet El” settlement from inside the camp. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:50, Israeli settler stormed Yabrud village, stoned residents and vehicles and as a result damaged a vehicle owned by Abdel Aziz Hamadan and injured his wife leaving her hospitalised with cuts from the glass shatters. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis village for Sabbath Holiday.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya, stormed and searched 3 homes then withdrew at 04:55. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 23:10, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jamal at checkpoint temporarily detained the child Mohammad Na’irat (15 years old), a resident of Jenin then released him at a later time. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p>TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Demonstration:</u> On the evening of February 1st 2014, a demonstration took place near Bissan Crossing in the North Jordan valley during which demonstrators were able to establish “Al-Awda village” by setting up tents in order to show Palestinian presence in the North Jordan valley as part of Palestinian occupied territory which was occupied in 1967.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to increase their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Kafriyat area located in south Tulkarem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Funduq village along the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus and detained 3 residents for allegedly carrying a hunting rifle. • <u>Raid:</u> At 19:45, Israeli forces raided Azzun, fired flash grenades towards the eastern area then surveyed agricultural land. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On January 31st 2014, Israeli forces positioned at the east entrance of Qalqiliya detained the child Suhayeb Ham (17 years old), a resident of Qalqiliya. (ii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Rasim Khaled, Mohammad Bayda and Muhsien Al-Khatib (All residents of Jayyus) Al-Funduq village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction was halted in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement for Sabbath holiday.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 09:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Shave Shomron” settlement junction. (ii) At 17:40 and again at 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq junction until 22:25. (iii) At 07:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beita junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Beita, set up a checkpoint thus preventing residents from entering or exiting the area for alleged firebombing a Israeli military vehicle during which they imposed a curfew on its residents and clashed with several residents, temporarily detained 4

SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 11:35 Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint until 12:10. • Raid: At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik until 21:35. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for Sabbath holiday.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:55 and again at 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at road (90) junction near Al-Nu'emeh village. (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction. • Detention: At 00:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Ein Hijleh village which was established in the North Jordan valley detained 9 residents: Omar Shalabi, Mohammad Mattar, Sami Abu Ghaliya, Mohammad Al-Khatib, Khalid Arabla, Nidal Abu Gharbiya, Musa Atiya, Walid Aliyan and Thaer Anas.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.

(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Since 14:00 on October 18th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Surif and Al-Jab'a village with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in West Beit Sahur. (ii) On the evening of February 1st 2014, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Beit Fajjar and detained a resident. • <u>Raid:</u> At 19:35 and again at 03:35, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed Contaniya Hotel, detained a resident then stormed and searched a home and detained another resident and withdrew at 04:05. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Khaled Taqatqa in Beit Fajjar (ii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Nidal Khalifa and Jamal Raba' in Bethlehem. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction was halted in North West of Beit Jala town due to severe weather conditions for Sabbath holiday. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

(iii) At 18:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00 and again at dawn on February 2nd 2014, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed and searched a home and several merchant shops and a vehicle spare parts shop then stormed another home and detained a residents. (ii) At 11:10, Israeli forces raided Ithna, stormed and searched 2 merchant shops and a bike repair shops. (iii) At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed and searched a home. (iv) At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Dura, detained a resident and summoned 2 residents: Yusef A-Fuqiya and Khalil Al-Manawra to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (v) On the evening of February 1st 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Thaher area located in Beit Ummar and stormed and searched a home. (vi) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Yatta. (vii) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp, stormed several homes and detained 3 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:45 on February 2nd 2014, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Al-Qawasmeh and Mu'taz Nasser Al-Din during their raid into Hebron as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Shabana in Hebron. (iii) Israel forces detained Omar Shinor in Dura. (iv) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mohammad Al-Adribat (16 years old), Mohammad Al-Badawi and Mohammad Sahjan in Al-Fuwar camp. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar temporarily detained Mufid Khalil then released him after assaulting him at 14:15. • <u>Attack:</u> At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired tear gas grenades towards several residents in the camp for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town for Sabbath holiday.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Central Gaza. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
