• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 12:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hizma.
- **Raid:** At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed and sear5ched several homes and as a result injured Mahmoud Abu Nassar and damaged a vehicle owned by Murad Hamad, detained six residents including a child then withdrew at 03:55.

• Detention:

- (i) On January 31st 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Majlis (A main entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem) detained Sabrin Abidat (A Journalist) {A resident of Jabal Mukabir Neighbourhood).
- (ii) Israeli forces detained 6 residents: Usayed Al-Zir (16 years old), Mohammad Mutier, Anas Manasir, Murad Hamad, Ibrahim Manasrah and Jallal Abu Usba' in Qalandiya camp.
- Attack: At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Amoud area in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- Assault on Places of Worship, At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.

On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and imped the free flow of traffic. Flying Checkpoint: At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Marda village.
JERICHO	 Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. Flying Checkpoint: At 09:35 and again at 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 20:00. Raid: (i) At 21:45, Israeli forces raided Marj Al-Na'jeh village until 22:10. BETHLEHEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; yadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.

- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint</u>: At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village until 23:10.

• Raid:

- (i) At 22:20, Israeli forces raided Husan village, set up two checkpoints at the east and west entrances, clashed with several residents and informed the local village council that the checkpoints will be in place for 3 days.
- (ii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and detained four residents.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained four residents: Dakhlalah Nuwarat, Musa Al-Salahat, Mu'tasim Al-Arouj and Imad Radaydeh in Bethlehem.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

(i) At 07:30 on February 1st 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction until 08:50.

- (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge until 17:00.
- Raid: At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed two buildings, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 03:35.

• Detention:

- (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Anan Abu Salah for allegedly carrying a knife.
- (ii) At 17:25, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Shuhada' road in the old city of Hebron detained Mohammad Al-Tamimi.
- (iii)At 17:35, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Sa'di Qazaz for allegedly carrying a knife.
- (iv)Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Wahid Al-Rajabi and Arafat Al-Batsh in Hebron.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood temporarily detained two children: Oday Abu Shamsiya (16 years

old) and Rami Abu Ayshah (16 years old) then released them at 16:20.

• Attack:

- (i) On the evening of February 1st 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Thaher area in Beit Ummar located near "Karmi Tsur" settlement fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 07:50, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several students and teachers for alleged stoning and as a result, left many of them suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces stormed Beit Ummar, served demolition orders for 2 homes located near road(60) owned by Mustafa Nujum, and Araf Nujum as well as confiscating a tractor owned by Ghazi Abu Ayash.
- <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 10:15, an Israeli Military Jeep ran over a herd of goats owned by Mazen Al-Awadeh and as a result killed 12 goats.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:20, an Israeli settler's vehicle ran over Raed Abu Irmeleh near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- The Israeli military broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
