#### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Raid: At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village and detained 3 residents including a child.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mahmoud Abu Rumi (16 years old), Ahmad Darwish and Yazan Muhisein.
- <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem, stormed the home of Mansour Abu Gharbiya, confiscated a computer and summoned his son Rami Abu Gharbiya to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, group Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 14:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Wa'ed Al-Tamimi (15 years old).

Flying Checkpoint: At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun until 21:15. Raid: (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Habalat, stormed and searched several merchant stores, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning and recorded their Identification numbers then withdrew at 14:30. (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, stormed and searched several home, damaged several home furniture, confiscated a computer, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:30. (iii) At 06:20, Israeli forces raided Azzun, temporarily detained several **QALQILIYA** residents at a bus station then released them after questioning. **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Adel Al-Loubani in Qalqiliya. **Wall Gates:** The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement. Closure: Since December 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-(i) Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of (viii) Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

#### Raid:

- (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr.
- (ii) At dawn on February 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, stormed and searched 2 homes and detained 2 residents.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Ahmad Tagatga and Mohammad Taqatqa in Beit Fajjar.
- Settler Violence: At 19:35, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Taqou' and damaged the limbs of several Olive trees then withdrew at 20:25.

#### **Wall Construction:**

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1<sup>st</sup> 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

#### Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

# (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

(vii) Since 09:45 on September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic

### **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Yunis area located along the main road connecting Hebron and Bethlehem.

# **HEBRON**

#### Raid:

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Rabboud village located in north of Al-Thahriya.
- (ii) At 11:10, Israeli forces raided Dur.

#### **Detention:**

- (i) At 04:30 on January 30<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Shindi after storming his home in Al-Thahriva.
- (ii) At 21:35, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Ashraf Fakhoury (17 years old) and Bashar Abboudo in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
- (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Ammar Abu Sha'ban.
- Attack: At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Urub camp fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
- Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching projectiles towards the Green Line
