JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 16:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic until 17:00. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeding the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Duqqu village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Qutna and Beit Annan villages and detained a resident in Qutna village. • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of February 3rd 2013, Israeli forces opened fire as they stormed a home in B’er Ayoub area in Silwan and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces detained Imad Absan as they stormed his home in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces detained Ahed Abbassi, Imad Abbassi, Maher Sarhan and Mahmoud Odeh in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Atara bridge and detained a resident. • Raid: At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Betuniya, stormed and searched 2 homes, detained a Palestinian Parliament member and summoned Majdi Qatush (a Palestinian Police officer) to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces positioned at Atara bridge detained Bashir Amer, a resident of Qalqiliya. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Atou, a Palestinian Parliament member in Betuniya. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Jenin, stormed a merchant store, temporarily detained and interrogated several residents and released them at a later time. (ii) At 17:35, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoints: The Israel army continues to intensify its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 01:25, Israeli forces Tulkarem and Tulkarem camp, stormed and searched several homes and the Palestinian Ministry of Religious Affairs center for charity, confiscated several computers and files as well as detaining 2 residents. • Detention: Israeli force detained Fadi Al-Amouri and Adnan Al- Hussari in Tulkarem. • Wall Gates: Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbat Suliman village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:25, Israeli forces raided Habalat village and stormed a home. (ii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, clashed with its residents as they stormed 2 homes, detained 2 residents and confiscated 2 computers. (iii) At 06:10, Israeli forces raided Jit village. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Raed Luwil and Muhsin Hardan in Qalqiliya. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement. (ii) On January 17th 2013, Israeli forces levelled residential land located at the eastern entrance of Azzun Atma for the purpose of constructing the Wall in the area.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Kalil village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:20, Israeli forces raided Beita and detained a resident. (ii) At 14:25, Israeli forces raided Orif village, clashed with its residents and detained 4 residents including a child. (iii) At 20:20, Israeli forces raided Burin village, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes, stormed an office and confiscated several office equipment and detained a resident. (iv) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qalil and detained a resident. (v) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Til village and detained a resident. (vi) At 07:30, Israeli forces raided Qarawit village and detained 5 residents.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and QatanAl-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Kafil Harris and Hariss village. (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Murad village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Jericho as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed a Synagogue. • <u>Detention:</u> On February 3rd 2013, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained Nayef Rjub , a resident of Dura upon his return from Jordan.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Duwara village located south of Sa'ir and served a confiscation order to seize 30 dunumes of land owned by Abdel Jalil Al-Mahdi. (ii) At 22:50 and again at 01:05, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained 2 residents including a Parliament member. (iii) 01:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahiriya and detained a Parliament member.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats of the shores of North Gaza.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination and allowed 79 truckloads of humanitarian goods. • <u>Attack:</u> At 08:45, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya.
