JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikse villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikse village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:00 on February 3rd 2015, Israeli forces detained Amjad Odwan during their raid into Qalandiya camp as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces detained Jihad Qaws after storming his home in the old city of Jerusalem. (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces detained four residents (including two children): Faysal Abu Al-Hawa (17 years old), Mohammad Abu Al-Hawa (17 years old), Salem Al-Abbassi and Ali Al-Abbassi. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 00:10, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship,</u> At 09:15, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 18:00, a group of demonstrators and International Peace activists attempted to install several tents on land in Khilat Al-Rihab area in Abu Dis which is under the threat of Israeli Military confiscation during which they clashed with Israeli forces and were forcibly removed from the area at 03:00 • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 18:50 on January 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the area between Al-Mughier village and a by pas road and the main road between Al-Mughier and Duma villages with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:00 and again at 21:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah Bridge in North Bir Zeit until 23:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city until 02:20. • <u>Detention:</u> At 18:45, Israeli forces detained Nash’at Al-Na’san (A resident of Al-Mughier village) as he was farming his agricultural land near the village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:10, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. (ii) At 16:05, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of “Ofar” military base fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Jaba’ until 13:00. • <u>Detention:</u> At 09:20, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Sawafta (A resident of Tubas) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 23:20. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Far’oun village until 16:00. (ii) At 15:25, Israeli force set up a checkpoint along Al-Kafriyat road, which connects Tulkarem and Qalqiliya until 16:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces raided Attil, stormed and searched several merchant shops then withdrew at 12:30. (ii) At 11:10, Israeli forces raided Baqa Al-Sharqiya, stormed and searched an Office, temporarily detained the owner: Shaddad Ammar and released him after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers then withdrew at 11:40.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

	<p>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 12:30. (ii) At 14:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Azzun bridge (along the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Tulkarem. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 20:10, an Israeli settler stormed Al-Funduq village, entered a cellular telephone shop owned by Rami Sawan (A resident of Immatin village) and stole a cellular telephone. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 16:35 and again at 22:10, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 23:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq, temporarily detained Imad Malitat (A resident of Beit Furiq) then released him later. (ii) At 13:30 and again at 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Osirin village until 21:30. (iii) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jama'in. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Qaballan and Talfit village until 12:30. (ii) At 15:05, Israeli forces raided Omdirin village, set up a checkpoint in the center of the village, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning during which residents clashed with Israeli forces as they detained a resident then withdrew at 15:50. (iii) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided the village of Tel, searched a house, and arrested one civilian then withdrew at 03:15. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Adeli in Osirin village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Suliman Hammad in Tel village.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) Since January 21st 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Deir Istiya with dirt mounds. • Checkpoints: At 15:40, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 11:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Salfit until 16:20. • Land Levelling: At 09:00, Israeli forces stormed Al-Waqa'a area in south east Iskaka village and levelled approximately 50 dunumes (acres) of land.

(ii) At 19:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 19:55. • Raid: At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Jericho, stormed a home, a building owned by the YMCA, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:30. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:45 on February 3rd 2015, Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohammad Baraqa, Ra'fat Suliman and Mohammad Ka'abneh during their raid into Aqbat Al-Jabr camp as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) Israeli forces detained Diya' Odeh in Jericho.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction until 20:00.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 10:10, Israeli forces raided Ithna, stormed a steel product shop owned by Husam Al-Sha'rawi, confiscated a tractor and summoned the owner to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 14:15.
 - (ii) At 10:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Ula, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 11:20.
 - (iii) At 14:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Karmil village and Ruq'a area located in east Yatta then stormed and searched a home.
 - (iv) At 15:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou', confiscated two agricultural tractors owned by Shihadeh Abu Awad and Khalil Abu Al-Hawa then withdrew at 16:20.
 - (v) At 16:25, Israeli forces raided Yatta.
 - (vi) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes, detained 2 children then withdrew at 02:40.
 - (vii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaqa village, stormed and searched several homes, detained 3 children then withdrew at 04:10.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 11:25, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained the child Ysef Qazaz (14 years old) {A resident of Dura} for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained two children: Ahmad Awad (17 years old) and Rashid Awad (17 years old) in Beit Umar.
 - (iii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohammad Abu Atwan (15 years old), Qusay Al-Atrash (15 years old) and Ahmad Harbiyat (16 years old).
- **Home Occupation:** At 21:00, Israeli forces stormed Al-Urub camp, occupied Mohammad Khirans home and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 22:00

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Gaza.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Detention: On the evening of February 3rd 2015, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Hanun (Erez) crossing detained Mohammad Al-Dawiya (A merchant) as he was attempting to travel to the West Bank.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Attack: At 21:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Shat'a camp located in west Gaza city.
