JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Bir Nabalah Bridge. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata and clashed with several residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Majlis gate (A main entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem) detained Bayan Al-Ju’beh (A journalist) {A resident of Jerusalem}. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood detained Mahmoud Abu Al-Hawa. (iii) At 06:30, Israeli forces detained two residents: Ameer Al-Hadrah and Ibrahim Al-Hadrah after storming their homes in Jerusalem city. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sinjil. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city until 20:10. (ii) At 20:55, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, detained a child then withdrew at 21:40. (ii) Israeli forces detained Arahimi (17 years old) and Ghassan Al-Rahimi in Beitv Rima. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:10, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> On February 4th 2015, Israeli forces served military orders for the demolition of four water wells owned by Nassar Issa, Yasser Salim, Basil Al-Taweel and Mohammad Salah in Silwad.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Arraba until 10:35. (ii) At 10:25 and again at 12:50, Israeli forces raided Jenin until 13:20. (iii) At 19:05, Israeli forces raided Bruqin, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 20:20. (iv) At 21:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Zababda until 22:00.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at Tayasir checkpoint temporarily detained Hamid Dabaq, Hussien Daraghmeh and Shaher Hussien then released them at 18:30.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 16:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces raided Izbit Al-Tayah and detained a resident. (ii) At 11:15, Israeli forces raided Anabta, positioned in front of Palestinian Police headquarters, temporarily detained a resident then released him after inspecting his identification card. (iii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:10.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:20 and again at 21:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 17:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Azzun Bridge (along the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Tulkarem. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 16:35 and again at 22:10, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 23:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 10:00. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) Since January 21st 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Deir Istiya with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 09:05, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:45. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Marda village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Sameer Abbas in Deir Istiya.

(ii) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village, stormed and searched Fakhri Atifats home and as a result damaged his furniture and assaulted home after summoning him to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:50.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road

HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘ Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Dura.

(ii) Israeli forces detained Badr Al-Darabi' (15 years old) in Al-Tabaqa village. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Yazan Taha until 14:35. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Jidawi Abu Haykal (A University Student) then released him at 16:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tabaqa village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over the child Jameel Al-Ja'bari (5 years old) along the main road near "Kiryat Arba'" settlement and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 14:50, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Al-Shallal road in the old city of Hebron stoned residents and vehicles.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
