JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army prevented civilians from other districts from entering Jerusalem. The Israeli authorities intensified restrictions at the entrances of the city and its neighborhoods. Separation Wall Construction: Construction of the separation wall in Al Eizariya, Abu Dis and Al Sawahira continues. House Demolition: The Israeli army demolished a 2 storey house in the neighborhood of Ras Khamis near Shu'fat refugee camp. The residence was home to 2 families comprised of 10 individuals. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Ahmad Khazna, a college student from the town of Silwad, at a checkpoint near Jerusalem.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Flving Checkpoints: At 12:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of the village of Kafr Malik, preventing civilians from entering or leaving the village. At 12:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of the town of Silwad and examined passenger ID's. At 18:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance to the city of El Bireh, near the neighborhood of Samir Amis. Separation Wall Construction: Construction of the western portion of the separation wall in Budrus and Rantis continues. Raids: At 12:40, the Israeli army raided the city of Ramallah and arrested 1 Palestinian National Security officer. At 18:30, an Israeli jeep raided the center of El Bireh city. At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Kharbatha Bani Harith and arrested 3 civilians, including 1 Palestinian Police officer. At 01:45, the Israeli army raided the city of Ramallah and searched 3 buildings located in the center of the city of Ramallah. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 1 civilian in the city of Ramallah: Rami Suleiman, a Palestinian National Security officer. The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the town of Kharbatha Bani Harith: Muhammad Ribhi; Nidal Wajih; and Fayiz Injas, a Palestinian Police officer.

 Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. Separation Wall Construction: Construction in the northern valleys (Bardala, and 'Ein al Beida) and east of Tubas (Al Mutilla, Al Mughayyir, the outskirts of Raba, and Al Buqei' plateau) continues. Raids: At 21:20, the Israeli army raided the center of the city of Jenin and opened fire. At 21:30, the Israeli army, including 30 jeeps supported by helicopters, raided the village of Birqin, imposed curfew, surrounded 1 house and demolished the house after evacuating its residents.
Activities not yet reported.
 Raid: At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem, searched several houses and arrested 5 civilians. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 5 civilians in the city of Bethlehem: Husam Al Yamani; Saed Hirmas; Ramzi Al Yamani; Ali Rashid; and Al Sheikh Khader Nawawra.
 Flying Checkpoints: At 07:50, and again at 14:30 and 21:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Kafr Al Labad and obstructed the passage of civilians. At 12:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Attil, searched and obstructed the passage of civilians. At 14:20, and again at 19:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Al Jarushiya and obstructed movement of traffic. Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. Raids: At 09:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Anabta, opened fire towards 1 vehicle and arrested its driver. At 10:25, the Israeli army raided Dahiyat Shuweika and opened

	indiscriminate fire.

	• Raid: At 03:20, the Israeli army raided Balata refugee camp, searched
	several houses and arrested 3 civilians, including 1 Palestinian Police
	officer.

SALFIT	 Flying Checkpoints: At 17:30, and again at 07:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the entrance to the village of Iskaka, searched vehicles and examined passenger IDs. Detention: The Israeli army detained 3 Palestinian National Security officers for several hours at Sarra checkpoint. Uprooting of Trees: At 09:00, the Israeli army uprooted trees that were planted by international peace activists, as an act of protest against the uprooting of trees for construction of the separation wall, near the separation wall in the village of Ballut. Air Patrol: At 12:40, Israeli helicopters patrolled the skies over the city.
