<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since January 6th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al –Eisawiya and clashed with residents. • <u>Injury:</u> On February 2nd 2012, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Al Za’im village physically assaulted Hassan Al Zir a resident of Bethlehem leaving him hospitalised with a broken leg. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 10:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al Taybeh. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Al Mughhir village, detained a resident and withdrew at 02:00. (ii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Al Nabi Saleh village, clashed with residents

	<p>as they searched several homes, detained and physically assaulted several residents including 2 children and withdrew at 06:30.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Bilal Abu Alia during their raid into Al-Mughayer village. (ii) Israeli force detained Loay Al-Tamimi and Ta'min Al-Tamimi during their raid into Al-Nabi Saleh village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Turat village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Jenin city and stormed several shops then withdrew at 12:00. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Sahel area in Yaabad and conducted military exercises. (iii) At 22:25, Israeli forces raided Yaabad. (iv) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Fakou village. (v) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Arraba. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 09:30, family members of Palestinian detainees marched to the centre of Jenin city in solidarity with detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 16:30 the Israeli army increased restrictions on Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.

<p>QALQILYA</p>	<p>the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Jit village junction. (ii) At 18:40 Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint along the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Azzun and searched 5 homes. (ii) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, stormed 2 homes, confiscated a personal computer and summoned Abdel Karim Abu Shaloush to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Anas Muslih during their raid into Qalqiliya. • <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 14:25, Israeli force escorting bulldozers levelled a plot of land in Kafr Qaddum belonging to Hassan Ishtawi. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqef village north of Karne Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00 (ii) At 05:00 Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. (iii) At 09:35, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at “Shave Shomron” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction. (ii) At 09:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Beit Furik junction. (iii) At 09:45 and again at 21:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at “Yitsahar” settlement.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iv) At 11:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Yazid village junction. (v) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Al-Maslakh area east of Nablus. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Amrin village until 14:45. (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Yazid village. (iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Talouza until 14:00. (iv) At 19:15, Israeli forces raided Jamain until 19:30. (v) At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Nablus, searched several homes, detained 6 residents and confiscated a computer then withdrew at 03:45. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Rami Issa, Fihmi Salim, Muin Ishbaro, Maher Shahin, Ziyad Jaarah and Alaa Al-Din Abu Khader during their raid into Nablus.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. (iii) At 18:00, on February 3rd 2012, the Israeli army closed the entrance to Kafr Al-Dik with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 12:20, the Israeli army continues to restrict access at the Zaatara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:05. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Yasouf village, searched several homes, detained 2 residents and withdrew at 03:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Osama Abdel Razeq and Yassin Obeid during their raid into Yasouf village. • <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces escorting bulldozers levelled civilian owned land in an area between Deir Istiya and Qarawat Bani Hassan. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces restricted access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley. (ii) Israeli forces continue restrict access at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Ein Dweik village. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho. • <u>Raid:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Jericho until 09:10
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.

<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<p>(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man; a road between Um Tuba and the Wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the Wall; the 2 by pass roads south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; the road between Al-Khader and road #60, which leads to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Humos: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Zaatara and a detour road; and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.</p> • <u>Raid:</u> <p>(i) On the morning of February 5th 2012, Israeli forces raided Harmala and summoned Ibrahim Ahmad to Israeli intelligence for questioning.</p> <p>(ii) At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Dar Salah village.</p> <p>(iii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, detained a resident and summoned Sultan Taqatqa to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.</p> <p>(iv) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Beit Sahur.</p> • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:50, Palestinian and international peace activists marched towards Al-Walaja to protest against land confiscation and wall construction. Israeli forces clashed with demonstrators and fired teargas grenades, causing several cases of suffocation from tear gas inhalation; they also detained Mazen Al-Azza and 3 international peace activists then released at 12:30. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was resumed northwest of Beit Jala town.
<p style="text-align: center;">Hebron</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</p> <p>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.</p> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.</p> <p>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.</p> <p>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to</p>

	<p>the entrance to Al-Simiya village.</p> <p>(v) Since 09:40 on 10.01.2012, Israeli forces continued closing the entrance of Beit Amra with concrete blocks.</p> <p>(i) <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></p> <p>(i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrances of Ithna.</p> <p>(ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of Hebron.</p> <p>(iii) At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ula. (ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces raided Yatta until 17:05. (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Al Samou. (iv) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Alamy during their raid into Beit Ummar. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 22:10, Israeli forces positioned in the Old City of Hebron detained several residents, including women and children. Israeli troops forcibly removed them from their homes as they searched them and fired stun grenades. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">Central Gaza</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detention: On the evening of February 5th 2012, Israeli forces detained 3 unidentified residents east of Al-Bureij camp for allegedly attempting to climb the border fence.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for critical patients, students and residents with special permits (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transportation of food supplies, goods, humanitarian aid, cooking gas, 29 truckloads of livestock feed, and construction cargo designated to internationally funded projects were allowed into Gaza while 1 shipment of flowers was allowed through for export.
