<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on February 5th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Jaderah village and searched two homes. (ii) At dawn on February 5th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ijza village and detained a resident after storming his home. (iii) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained a child. (iv) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Biddu and detained three residents. (v) At dawn on February 6th 2015, Israeli forces raided AL-Ram and detained a resident after storming his home. (vi) At dawn on February 6th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Mus’ab Zahran in Beit Ijza. (ii) Israeli forces detained Imad Abu Rayalah (17 years old) in Al-Eisawiya. (iii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Amin Hamadin, Mus’ab Hamadin and Majd Zahran in Biddu. (iv) Israeli forces detained Ehab Aliyan in Al-Ram. (v) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Obied in Al-Eisawiya. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained three residents (Known of them are): Sabrin Thiyab. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 13:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 18:50 on January 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the area between Al-Mughier village and a by pas road and the main road between Al-Mughier and Duma villages with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Um Safa village. (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Ziet until 22:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:50, Israeli forces raided Ni’lin, clashed with several residents until 12:00. (ii) At 13:05, Israeli forces raided Kharbathat Al-Misabah village, clashed with several residents and as a result suffocated Aziza Jamaal from tear gas inhalation then withdrew at 14:30. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:15 and again at 19:50 Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Dajanah Anbar (14 years old) {A resident of Al-Jalazoun camp}. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Silwad fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:10, a group of Israeli settlers installed several tents near the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village and raised several Israeli flags then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces at 09:40.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Zubaba village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad, clashed with several residents and as a result injured two children: Mahmoud Hamarsheh (14 years old) and Abdel-Rahman Mir’I (17 years old) and at 03:25 stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:15.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces stormed the area west of Bardalah village and while conducting Military training proceeded to damaged

	300 dunumes (acres) of agricultural land planted with wheat and chickpeas owned by Akram Fuqaha, Hayel Sawafta, Ahmad Sawafta, Abdel-Hamid Sawafta, Eyad Sawafta, Omar Sawafta and Bassim Fuqaha.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:15.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 22:45. • <u>Raid:</u> At 09:35, Israeli forces raided Asalah village until 10:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in south Qalqiliya fired stun grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 19:45, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of “Tsvim” settlement located in Nort Qalqiliya temporarily detained two children: Mohammad Abu Hammad (13 years old) and Na’im Abu Hammad (13 years old) as they were collecting scrap metal in the area then released them at 22:15. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:30, a group of Israeli settlers from “Qadumim” settlement stormed Kafr Qaddum and sprayed toxic chemicals on several Olive trees owned by Abdallah Jum’a. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30 and again at 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Dajjan until 19:30. (ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Duma village junction until 20:30. • Land Levelling: At 14:20, Israeli forces stormed Sarah village and levelled a plot of land owned by Mohammad Abdallah. • Settler Violence: At 14:15, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Jabal Sabah area located in south Beita and set up several tents and Mobile homes then proceeded to raise several Israeli flags in an attempt to create a settlement outpost then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) Since January 21st 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Deir Istiya with dirt mounds. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 09:25. (ii) At 14:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ain Al-Dweik village located in North Jericho until 16:00. • Detention: At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Anas Mazahim (A resident of Abboun town in Ramallah) as he was returning from Jordan. • Temporary Detention: At 16:35, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Hamrah checkpoint temporarily detained Saleh Abu Zabidah (A resident of Al-Zubidat village) then released him later.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from

accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
 - (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
 - (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
 - (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
 - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
 - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
 - (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- **Temporary Detention:** At 15:35, Israeli forces temporarily detained two residents: Billal Al-Tanah and Ma'moun Ta'amreh as they were herding their sheep near the north entrance of Taqou' then released them at 20:30.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 13:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Huwar area junction located in North Halhul , temporarily seized a National Security Force vehicle then allowed it to pass through later.
 - (ii) At 15:40, Israel forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge.
 - (iii) At 15:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction.
 - (iv) At 17:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fahs area located in south Hebron, detained a resident after confiscating his vehicle.
- **Raid:** At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Hebron.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 13:05, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 19:25, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron opened fire towards a resident and detained him after injuring him for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
 - (iii) On the evening of February 5th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Thaher area located in Beit Ummar area “Kurmi Tsur” settlement fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 14:35, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Mohammad Al-Hadad (14 years old).
 - (ii) Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Fahs atrea located in south Hebron detained Ammar Abu Sbieh.
 - (iii) Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron detained Sa'ed Haddad after injuring him.

GAZA STRIP

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Attack: At dawn on January 6th 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach located in West Beit Lahiya.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">KHAN YUNIS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: On the evening of February 5th 2015, Israeli forces opened fire and launched smoke grenades from their positions behind the Green Line towards agricultural land in east Al-Qarara.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
