JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army prevented civilians from other districts from entering Jerusalem to observe Friday prayers at Al Aqsa mosque, forcing thousands of worshipers to pray at checkpoints and in public areas. The Israeli authorities intensified restrictions at the entrances of the city and its neighborhoods. • Separation Wall Construction: Construction of the separation wall in Al Eizariya, Abu Dis and Al Sawahira was suspended for the weekend.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Separation Wall Construction: Construction of the western portion of the separation wall in Budrus and Rantis was suspended for the weekend. • Attack: At 14:00, during the burial ceremony of a woman in Al Jalazun refugee camp, confrontations with Israeli soldiers and civilians erupted after several soldiers in an Israeli army jeep fired live fire towards civilians, injuring 1 child. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:40, the Israeli army raided the city of Ramallah and El Bireh, opened fire in the neighborhood of Al Tira and searched 1 building in the neighborhood of Im al Sharayit. (ii) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Kafr 'Ein and patrolled the area. • Injuries: <p>The Israeli army injured 2 civilians during a demonstration in Biddu:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Khalil Shuqeir; and (ii) Ali Hussein. <p>The Israeli army injured 1 child in Al Jalazun refugee camp:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) Salih Abu Sharifa, 14 years old. • Demonstration: At 14:00, a demonstration in protest of construction of the separation wall took place in the town of Biddu. The Israeli army opened live fire and fired rubber coated steel bullets at protesters, injuring 2 civilians.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. • Separation Wall Construction: Construction in the northern valleys

	(Bardala, and 'Ein al Beida) and east of Tubas (Al Mutilla, Al Mughayyir, the outskirts of Raba, and Al Buqei' plateau) was suspended for the weekend.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The town of Al Walaja remains isolated due to the closure of the Beit Jala/Al Walaja road by dirt and rock mounds. Health facilities and food supplies are increasingly difficult to access. • Raid: At 00:15, an Israeli jeep raided the city of Bethlehem and took position in Ras Beit Jala.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flying Checkpoints: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:45, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of the town of Bal'a, searched civilians and obstructed movement of traffic. (ii) At 15:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the main road between the towns of Iktaba and Anabta and arrested 1 civilian. (iii) At 17:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Attil, searched civilians and obstructed movement of traffic. • Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, the Israeli army raided the towns of Anabta and Kafr Al Labad. (ii) At 13:40, the Israeli army raided Izbat Abu Khmesh, east of Dahiyat Dhinnaba, and took position on a hill in the area. (iii) At 13:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Iktaba. (iv) At 14:40, the Israeli army raided Tulkarem refugee camp and took position at its entrance. (v) At 18:30, 2 Israeli jeeps raided the southern part of Tulkarem city. (vi) At 19:10, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the town of Far'un, forced civilians to close their shops without announcing curfew, and arrested 2 children. (vii) At 17:20, the Israeli army, including 6 jeeps, raided the towns of Attil and Deir al Ghusun and opened indiscriminate fire. (viii) At 03:30, the Israeli army raided Tulkarem refugee camp, searched houses and imposed curfew. • Air Patrol: At 15:35, Israeli reconnaissance aircraft patrolled the skies over the area of Al Khalayil, located between the towns of Dhinnaba and

	<p>Kafr al Labad.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 children in the town of Far'un: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Tahaddi Jihad Habib, 15 years old; and (ii) Ahmad Anwar Salameh, 17 years old. <p>The Israeli army arrested 1 civilian on the main road between Iktaba and Anabta:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) Iyad Ammar, a Palestinian National Security officer.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raids: At 14:30, Israeli Special Forces raided 'Asker refugee camp, searched several houses and arrested 4 civilians. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians in 'Asker refugee camp: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Muhammad Odeh; (ii) Majdi Odeh; (iii) Hamada Odeh; and (iv) Wasim al Sadir.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activities not yet reported.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flying Checkpoint: At 12:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Iskaka bridge, searched vehicles and examined passenger IDs. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli army soldiers raided the city of Salfit and searched several houses. (ii) At 01:15, the Israeli army raided the city of Salfit and fired sound bombs.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Erez crossing was partially open to workers. • Attack / Destruction of Property: At 17:10, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from its location west of Point 39 towards Palestinian Territory east of Beit Hanoun, killing 10 cows. • Palestinian Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:50, 2 Qassam mortars were fired from the area of the eastern

GAZA CITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al Shuhada' junction (Nitsareem) remains closed. (ii) Al Muntar crossing (Karnei) was partially opened.
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activities not yet reported.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Abu al Ajin road (Khan Yunis Al Sharqiya) remains closed. (ii) Western road (Khan Yunis) remains closed. (iii) Abu Holi road is partially open. (iv) Khan Yunis/Al Mawasi road remains closed. • Attacks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from Point 9 towards civilian houses in the western neighborhood. (ii) At 21:30, the Israeli army opened intensive fire and fired 1 tank shell from Point 12 towards civilian houses in Al Nimsawi neighborhood.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Gaza International Airport remains closed. (ii) Sufa crossing remains closed. • Attacks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:15, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from Points 8.5 and 9 towards civilian houses in Tel Zu'rob and Yabna refugee camp, injuring 1 civilian. (ii) At 15:35, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from the settlement of Morag towards civilian houses in Tel Zu'rob and Yabna refugee camp, seriously injuring 1 child in the neck. • Injuries: The Israeli army injured 2 civilians in Yabna refugee camp: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Akram Abu al Owf; and (ii) Muhammad Dhahir, 2 years old.
