<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints set up at entrances to the occupied city of Jerusalem and Al Aqsa Mosque, and prevent civilians from other districts from entering the city, except those possessing Israeli permits.</li> <li>(ii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued military order # S/02/09 closing the seam line area, an extension of the Wall.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill located in an area between the villages of Biddu and Beit Ikse.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al Bareed in Jerusalem city from the town of Ar Ram.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Beit Ikse, which leads to the city of Jerusalem, by an iron gate, and allows civilians access to occupied Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint only.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and only allows holders of Jerusalem IDs to access the city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>(ii) At 13:50, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Jaba' checkpoint on the road linking the districts of Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho districts and impeded civilian access.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 10:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to the town of Ar-Ram, detained a civil police vehicle and allowed it to pass at 11:30 after inspecting the IDs of police officers inside it.</li> <li>• <b><u>Provocation of Palestinian Forces:</u></b> At 10:25, the Israeli army detained at Jaba' checkpoint, that is set up on the road linking the districts of Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho, a Palestinian National Security vehicle, took photographs for 4 officers inside it and allowed it to pass at 10:45 following DCO intervention.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>outside the village through Habla town gate, while allowing the passage of civilians through gate # 109.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction continues on land belonging to the village of Kafr Laqif, north of the settlement of Karni Shomron, on land belonging to the village of Immatin, northeast of the settlement of ‘Amano’el, and east of the town of Kafr Thulth near the settlement of Ma’aleh Shomron.</li> </ul>
<b>NABLUS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osarin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osarin.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to the town of Qabalan; the southern entrances to the villages of Duma and Qaryut; and the western entrance to An Naqura village opposite Shavei Shomron settlement.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only from 07:00 until 02:00.</li> <li>(ii) Awarta commercial checkpoint is open for civilians from 05:00 until 20:00 and on Friday from 05:00 until 15:00.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to the village of Qusin and searched civilians and vehicles until 10:55.</li> <li>(ii) At 15:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to the village of Sarra (on Nablus – Qalqiliya main road). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impede civilian access.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Yasuf, set up a flying checkpoint at its entrance and patrolled the area until 10:15.</li> <li>(ii) At 03:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Qarawat Bani Hassan, searched 2 houses and withdrew at 04:30.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Land Leveling:</u></b> On 06 February 2011, the Israeli army leveled an area of land containing antiquities in the area of Deir Sam'an which belongs to the town of Kafr Ad Dik that is located near the settlement of 'Elli Zahaf.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction continues in the area north of the town of Deir Istiya (southeast of the settlement of 'Amanu'el).</li> </ul>
<b>JERICHO</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at al-Hamra checkpoint and allow civilian access from 06:00 until 22:00.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja and allow access only to civilians holding Jericho and Jordan Valley IDs and those with permits.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho. Again at 11:20, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions and impeded civilian access.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 15:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint under the overpass leading to the town of Al Khadr (on the road that leads to the western villages of Bethlehem district) and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 01:40, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem, the town of Ad Doha and Ayda refugee camp in the city and served summons to 3 civilians to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency.</li> <li>(ii) At 01:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the villages of Ash Shawawra and Bureid'a.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khadr and Beit Jala city; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of Ephrata settlement; and in the area surrounding al-Walaja village.</li> </ul>
<b>HEBRON</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to al Laban Market by iron boards. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruit and vegetable market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.</li> <li>(ii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued military order # 09/06 closing the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta, evacuating those inside it and preventing civilians from accessing it. This is the land seized for military purposes for the construction of the Wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa; the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron; the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp; the village of At Tuwani as well as the entrance to the town of Adh Dhahiriya.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Ash Shalala Old Street in the old city of Hebron.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the villages of Al Karmil and At Tuwani and all roads leading to bypass Road # 60.</li> <li>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the side roads off the bypass road leading to the town of Yatta.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- **Flying Checkpoints:**

- (i) At 08:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance to the city of Hebron (off bypass road # 35 near Halhul town overpass) and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 08:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass leading to Halhul town and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 08:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrances to the towns of Bani Na'im and Beit Kahil.
- (iv) At 10:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Idhna and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (v) At 21:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to the village of Khursa and searched civilians and vehicles.

- **Raids:**

- (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron.
- (ii) At 13:00, the Israeli army raided the village of At-Tabaqa and arrested a civilian.
- (iii) At 13:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area located east of Sa'ir town.
- (iv) At 17:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Ummar where confrontations took place with civilians injuring 2 civilians, including 16-year-old child Ala' Ibrahim Abu Mariya who was hit by a stun grenade while inside her house. The Israeli army arrested 3 children.
- (v) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir Samit, searched a house and served summon to the civilian Muhammad Majed Sharawneh to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency.
- (vi) At 01:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit 'Awwa and searched a number of houses.
- (vii) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Adh Dhahiriya, searched a house and served summon to the civilian Anwar Muhammad Samamrah to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency.

- **Arrests**

- (i) The Israeli army arrested in the village of At-Tabaqa the civilian Raed Badawi Hamdan.
- (ii) The Israeli army arrested in the town of Beit Ummar: Muhammad Jamil Abu Mariya, 16-year-old; Khaled Ibrahim Khadr Sabarneh, 14-year-old; and Muhammad Ibrahim Abdulhameed Abu Mariya, 17-year-old.

- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, in the periphery of Eshkolot settlement southwest of Adh Dhahiriya town and between southwest of Arab Ar Ramadin village and the village of Imneizil.

In the meantime, armed Palestinian groups declared a one-week-long ceasefire. Meanwhile, the ceasefire was extended until 05 February 2009. The ceasefire is holding despite the end of the specified period.</li> <li>• The Israeli army violated the ceasefire when Israeli navy boats opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats at sea in Gaza district.</li> <li>• Armed Palestinian groups violated the ceasefire by firing 2 mortars towards the Green Line.</li> </ul>
<p><b>NORTHERN GAZA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Crossing Point:</b> Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open for the passage of critically ill civilians, foreign journalists, the staff of international humanitarian organizations, traders, businessmen and civilians travelling through Al Karama Crossing who have prior coordination.</li> </ul>
<p><b>GAZA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Crossing Points:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed.</li> <li>(ii) Al-Shuja'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing for fuel transport is closed since 04 January 2010 by an Israeli unilateral decision.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b>Attack:</b> In the morning of 06 February 2011, Israeli navy boats opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats at sea opposite Gaza city beach.</li> </ul>
<p><b>CENTRAL GAZA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Events not reported.</li> </ul>
<p><b>KHAN YOUNIS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Palestinian Attack:</b> In the evening of 06 February 2011, 2 mortars were fired towards the Green Line.</li> </ul>
<p><b>RAFAH</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Crossing Points:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Rafah (Al Awdah) Crossing is closed.</li> <li>(iii) Sufa Crossing is closed.</li> <li>(iv) Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the entry of food, humanitarian assistance and the export of 7 truckloads of strawberries and flowers.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>
