JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since January 6th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Kafr Aqab village and detained a resident. (ii) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Biddu. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces Ahmad Kawazba (15 years), a resident of Hebron, for allegedly entering Jerusalem without a valid permit. (ii) Israeli forces detained Rami Fadail during their raid into Kafr Aqab village. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of

(ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Shuqba until 22:00. (iii) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Ein Yabrud, stormed several homes and detained 2 residents. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.

The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of Karne Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.

On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00 (ii) At 05:00 Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. (ii) At 01:30, a group of Israeli settlers raided Al-Luban Al-Sharqiya and spray-painted racist slogans on the walls.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. (iii) Since 18:00 on February 3rd 2012, the Israeli army closed the western entrance to Kafr Al Dik with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to increase restrictions on access at the Za'tara checkpoint and impedes the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrances of Kafil Hares and Hares village. (ii) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the western junction of Deir Istiya. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On February 6th 2012, Israeli forces raided Harres village, served 6 demolition orders and 2 halt of construction notices to Ihsan Suf, Husam Suf, Yasser Suliman, SaberDaud, Faris Daud and Fahed Daud for allegedly not

JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces restricted access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley. BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al Khader; the road between Al Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (i) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Nafi Danial" settlement and agricultural land in Al Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 16:15, the Israeli army increased restrictions at the Container checkpoint until 19:00. • Flying Checkpoint: At 11:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Dar Salah village. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on February 6th 2012, Israeli forces raided Aida camp in Bethlehem and detained Sabrin Darwish, releasing her at a later time. (ii) At 12:50, Israeli forces raided Dar Salah village, stormed a home and withdrew at 13:10.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) At 13:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Sahur, served 2 demolition notices for homes owned by Fadi Al-Bour and Shadi Al-Bour. (iv) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Aza refugee camp in Bethlehem, detained a resident and withdrew at 05:45. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned at the Container checkpoint detained Mohanad Al-Jamur. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Shaaira during their raid into Bethlehem. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.
Hebron	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village. (v) Since 09:40 on 10.01.2012, Israeli forces continued closing the entrance of Beit Amra with concrete blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Beit Anun village junction. (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint in Wadi Qabbun area located north of Hebron. (iii) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Surif and Khursa. (iv) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Al-Thahiriya. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli force raided Taffuh village and searched a home. (ii) At 19:10, Israeli forces raided Dura and took up position near Palestinian intelligence offices. • <u>Detention:</u> At 13:05, the Israeli army increased restrictions in the Old city of Hebron, set up several checkpoints and closed several roads as Israeli settlers raided Al-Ibrahimi Mosque. Israeli forces also increased restrictions on Qurtuba School, alleging that stoning incidents occurred. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces ordered Adham Al-Tal to vacate his land located in Al-Thahiriya. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:30, a group of Israeli settlers raided residential land in Hebron and planted several trees. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 11:00, family members of detainees marched in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Hebron in solidarity with detainees and to demand their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. • On the evening of February 6th 2012, Israeli fighter jets and helicopters surveyed the skies of Gaza. • Palestinian gunmen opened fire towards the Green Line.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
Central Gaza	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detention: As mentioned in the report of February 5th 2012, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Awawdeh, Yusef Al Oweidat and Mohammad Ismail as they attempted to climb over the border fence.
Khan Yunis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Palestinian Attack: On the evening February 6th t 2012, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.

(ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for critical patients, students and residents with special permits (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transportation of food supplies, goods, humanitarian aid, cooking gas, 8 truckloads of wheat, 30 imported vehicles, construction cargo designated to internationally funded projects were allowed through while 1 shipment of tomatoes was allowed through for export.
