#### **WEST BANK**

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

**JERUSALEM** 

#### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Ram.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Hizma village and detained 3 residents.

- Attack: At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem fired tear gas grenades towards several worshipers.
- <u>Destruction of Property:</u> Israeli forces stormed Jabal Al-Mukkabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem and demolished a livestock den owned by Nassar Shqirat for allegedly being built without a licence.
- Assault on Property: At 15:30, Israeli forces stormed Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem and stormed a club while forcing several residents out of the building in order to prevent a solidarity poem reciting campaign hosted by Poet Raniya Hatem.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 06:00, Israeli; forces stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and forcibly removed several worshipers from the mosque, sprayed pepper spray onto their faces and assaulted them then detained a resident.

#### • Detention:

- (i) On February 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Nidal Bashir in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Badr in Al-Eisawiya village.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Ahmad Nimr, Abdallah Nimr and Ahmad Manasra in Hizma village.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Hazim Siyam at the entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints at Ein Yabrud village junction, Ein Sinya junction and "Halamish" settlement junctions, temporarily detained 4 residents including 2 Security force officer: Mohammad Al-Tamimi, Mahmoud Al-Tamimi, Jabr Al-Tamimi and Arafat Najlat then released them at 10:15.
- (ii) At 21:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al village until 23:55.
- (iii) At 22:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp and temporarily detained Salah Al-Safi (A national Security officer) then released him at a later time.

- (iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) Since January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

#### Raid

- (i) At 10:55 and again at 05:30, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem.
- (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed a home then withdrew at 01:25.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near Nahalin village' fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained the child Adel Ghayatha (12 years old) then withdrew at 20:50.
- <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 08:50, Israeli forces raided Wadi Fuqin village, levelled 6 acres of land and uprooted 100 Olive trees owned Mahmoud Atuya, Ishaq Mansour, Jamal Atta and Amin Atiya.

#### • Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1<sup>st</sup> 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21<sup>st</sup> 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

#### **HEBRON**

- (vi) Since December 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic
  - <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction.
- Raid: At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Dura, temporarily detained 2 residents: Yazan Sharif and Ahmad Al-Rajjabi then withdrew at 23:00.
- **<u>Detention</u>**: On February 5<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained Munthir Al-Fakhouri as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence in south Hebron based on a prior summon.
- Temporary Detention:
- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Billal Salaymeh then released him at a later time.
- (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Shalaysheh road in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained the child Muhanad Al-Natsheh (12 years old) then released him at a later time.

#### • Attack:

- (i) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp junction fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Khader Janazara leaving hospitalised with contusions.
- (ii) At 17:25, Israeli forces positioned near Khursa and Al-Tabaqa villages fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning a
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

### ALL DISTRICTS

- At 21:00 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis and Rafah.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah.
- Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching projectiles towards the Green Line.

### NORTHERN GAZA

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.

#### • Palestinian Attack:

- (i) On the afternoon of February 6<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
- (ii) On the evening of February  $6^{\text{th}}$  2014 , Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line
