JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On February 6th 2015 The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers from other Districts from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) At 20:15, Israeli forces closed Wadi Al-Hilweh road in Silwan neighbourhood and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) Since September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, stormed several homes and summoned two residents: Maher Basa and Mohammad Ma’touq to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jal junction located near Ras Kabsa area in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:30, a group of Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles passing along a bypass road near “Kaghav Yacoub” settlement. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since 18:50 on January 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Mugheir village and a bypass road and a road connecting Al-Mughier and Duma villages with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah Bridge until 17:30. (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Turmus’aya and detained a resident. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:55, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 14:00. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Rantis village. (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, stormed a building, and confiscated a surveillance camera footage from Safi Al-Ramahis apartment then withdrew at 02:45. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Ashqar in Turmus’aya. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:05, Israeli forces positioned at Atarah bridge located in North Bir Ziet fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. (ii) At 13:25, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured Naser Safi (16 years old). (iii) At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of “Ofar” Military Base/ Prison fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mohammad Muslih. (iv) At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Eyad Hamad. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 12:50, a demonstration took place in Ni’lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 12:50, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result, left several others suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Taybeh village until 23:55. (ii) At 23:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village until 00:10.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 20:45, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem until 05:50. (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Bal’a until 05:50. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 20:25, Israeli forces positioned near wall gate (639) temporarily detained three children (All residents of Kafr Jamal village): Yazid Mustafa (14 years old), Alaa Tawiya (14 years old) and Wurud Hamdan (14 years old) then released them at 00:20.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 22:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in south Qalqiliya fired stun grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:05, Israeli forces temporarily detained three residents: Subhi Khaled, Firas Khaled and Abed Khaled near Bir Buwik located near Jayyus until 18:00. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:55, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried to disrupt the demonstration and as a result injured 3 residents: Abed Ishtewi, Maher Jum’a and Nofal Jallal Nofal and also injured 2 journalist Mohammad Nofal and Abdel-Rahman Qussini after tear gas grenades struck them as well as leaving 2 residents including a child and woman suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army closed with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 11:10 on January 21st 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Deir Istiya with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafil Harris, • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:01, an armed Israeli settler positioned near Za'tarah checkpoint aimed his weapon towards Alaa Hassan (A resident of Ramallah) as he was crossing the checkpoint.

(ii) At 10:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 12:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Ni'meh Al-Haj (A resident of Ramallah) then allowed her to pass through at 15:00.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man:

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
