	(ii) At 05:00 Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.
	(iii) At 15:55, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions on "Shave Shomron" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:30.

	Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
	(ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.
	(iii) Since 18:00 on February 3rd 2012, the Israeli army closed the western entrance to Kafr Al Dik with dirt mounds.

Checkpoints: At 08:00, Israeli forces restricted access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up (i) along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley. Israeli forces continue restrict access at the checkpoint set up on the junction (ii) to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. Flying Checkpoints: At 08:20, 14:45, 20:30 and 07:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho. **Closure:** The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the (i) exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Oumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" (i) settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and BETHLEHEM Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Tagou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. Raids: At dawn on February 7th 2012, Israeli forces raided Al-Fardies village and (i) detained a resident. At dawn on February 7th 2012, Israeli forces raided Za'atra and temporarily (ii) detained Daud Thuweib. (iii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Husan village, searched a home and withdrew at 03:30. **Detention:** On February 5th 2012 Israeli forces positioned at the Container checkpoint (i) detained Eyad Abu Zahra. (ii) Israeli forces detained Hassan Abu Mahamid during their raid into Al-Fardies Settler Violence: At 10:45, a group of Israeli settlers raided 3 dunums of land located in Wadi Fukin village and placed barbed wire around olive trees owned by Mustafa Hurub and Nasri Hurub. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town. **Closure:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the (ii)Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall

construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied then	n
access to the area.

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
- (v) Since 09:40 on 10.01.2012, Israeli forces continued closing the entrance of Beit Amra with concrete blocks.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Ithna village junction.
- (ii) At 10:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Awa.
- (iii) At 11:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al Karmil village.

• Raids:

- (i) At dawn on February 7th 2012, Israeli force raided Hebron and searched a
- (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Karmel, occupied the rooftop to Rateb Al-Jubur's home, and searched 3 homes while detaining its residents then withdrew at 14:00.
- (iii) At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Ula, served a notice to Lurthat Al-Amla to withdraw from her land while seizing a tractor owned by Zakariya Al-Ama.
- (iv) At 15:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya.
- (v) At 17:35, Israeli forces raided Ma'in village and searched a home.
- (vi) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Kahel and searched a home.
- (vii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, searched several homes, detained 2 residents and temporarily detained Isam Al-Alamy.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Nadim Al-Khalil and Ra'fat Al-Alami during their raid into Beit Ummar
- <u>Home Occupation:</u> At 06:50, Israeli forces occupied the home of Atiya Al-Jabarni, detained its residents into a single room and converted its rooftop into a military post.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) On February 7th 2012, a group of Israeli settlers, under the protection of Israeli forces, destroyed 25 olive tree branches planted on January 31st 2012 in Beit Ummar.
- (ii) On February 7th 2012, a group of Israeli settlers placed barbed wire around 3 dunums in an attempt to seize land owned by Al-Jubur family.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Israeli forces opened fire towards Khan Yunis and Israeli Helicopters opened fire towards agricultural land in north Gaza. On the evening of February 7th 2012, Israeli fighter jets surveyed the skies of Gaza.

NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. Attack: At 19:05, Israeli helicopters opened fire towards agricultural land in Beit Hanun.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
KHAN YUNIS	• <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of February 7 th 2012, Israeli forces opened fire towards agricultural land in Khaza'a.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for critical patients, students and residents with special permits. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transportation of food supplies, goods, humanitarian aid, cooking gas, construction cargo designated to internationally funded projects were allowed through while 1 shipment of tomatoes was allowed through for export.
