JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 16:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic until 17:00. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeding the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Qatanna village and searched 3 homes. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village and clashed with several demonstrators protesting in solidarity with Palestinian detainees • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> At 20:25, Israeli forces detained 2 children: Nimer Qabani (17 years

	<p>old) and Mohammad Baker (17 years old) in Al-Thuri neighbourhood in Jerusalem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces served demolition order to demolish a home owned by Khalid Al-Obiedi in Beit Hanina for allegedly being built without proper licensing. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:40, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem, provoked several worshipers and held up a staute. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Jerusalem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atara bridge until 16:30. (iii) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ur Al-Tahta. • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of February 7th 2013, Israeli forces positioned near Budrus village fired tear gas and stun grenades towards several youths as they sneaked through the wall gate and began a soccer match on land behind the wall gate and as a result leaving them suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 22:30, Israeli settlers stone vehicles passing through the main road leading to Jalazun camp and damaged the vehicle of Mohammad Nakhla, a resident of Jalazun camp. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Ya'bad and Zabada village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Hafira village near Arraba as they escorted several settlers while storming an archaeological site then withdrew at 14:10. (ii) At 10:45 and again at 17:30, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad, clashed with residents as they stormed and searched a Solon shop. (iii) At 11:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Zabadiya.

	<p>(iv) At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Jenin.</p> <p>(v) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village until 01:40.</p> <p>(vi) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Fahma village, clashed with its residents as they stormed 5 homes and fired tear gas grenades which left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces detained Samah Al-Qut, a resident of Jenin as she was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to including intensify its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and prevented residents from entering the area.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israel army continues to intensify its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 01:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Allar. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:25, Israeli forces raided Irtah neighbourhood in Tulkarem. (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Sayda village and stormed. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> At 10:00, Israeli military bulldozer's levelled a plot of land near Kafr Al-Jamal located near "Si'lit" village for the purpose of settlement expansion. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Azzun and Izbit Al-Tabib and detained 2 residents. • <u>Raids:</u> At 19:55, Israeli forces raided Azzun, set up a checkpoint at its entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic until 20:40. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in west Jayyus opened fire towards several residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Yusef Salim and Ysef Saqr Salim between Izbit Al-Tabib and Azzun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students

	<p>to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement. (ii) On January 17th 2013, Israeli forces levelled residential land located at the eastern entrance of Azzun Atma for the purpose of constructing the Wall in the area. (iii) At 09:50, Israeli military bulldozers levelled residential land in Jayyus for the purpose of Wall construction and uprooted 60 olive trees owned by Hassan and Abdullah Khalid.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Yatma until 13:25. (ii) At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 14:40. (iii) At 18:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Burin village junction until 18:30. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On February 7th 2013, Israeli settlers pumped sewage waste towards residents and agricultural land in Sabastiya village and polluted several agricultural crops. (ii) At 15:10, Israeli settlers stormed Orif village under the protection of Israeli forces that fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and QatanAl-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on February 7th 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya and detained a resident. (ii) At 20:00 and at 01:40, Israeli forces raided Kafil Harris until 02:20. (iii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Salfit, stormed the headquarters of the Palestinian detainees club and damaged the main entrance and summoned Salim Al-Masri to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.

JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Jericho until 23:55. • <u>Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Humra checkpoint detained Khalid Katishat, a resident of Tubas. (ii) On February 7th 2013, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained Rafat Omar, a Presidential Security Officer as he was returning from Jordan.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou' until 13:45. • <u>Attack:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned at a military post in Al-Adey camp fired stun grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Aid'eis Taqatqa in Beit Fajjar. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 10:25, Israeli forces demolished a home owned by Raed Alliyani in Beit Sahur for allegedly being built without proper licensing. • <u>Demonstration:</u> On the evening of February 7th 2013, a demonstration took place in Beit Ummar in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town.

Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles.

<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination and allowed 79 truckloads of humanitarian goods. • <u>Detention:</u> On the morning of February 5th 2013, Israeli forces positioned at Erez crossing detained Rami Al-Tib and Mohammad Al-Tib after they received entry permits into Israel.
<p>GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p>RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, passengers with permits and 83 truckloads of construction material for internationally funded projects. • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of humanitarian supplies, cooking gas 24 truckloads of manufacturing goods and construction material for internationally funded projects.

- An Israeli military court in Ofar prison sentenced Abdel Jabbar Hassanat, a resident of Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem to 2 years imprisonment and fined him 1000 NIS approximately \$270.
