#### **Closure:** (i)

- Since January 6<sup>th</sup> 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City.
- The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### **Closure of Main Roads:**

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (iii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint.

#### **Checkpoints:**

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandia checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) Israeli forces continue to close the entrance to the Shofat refugee camp with cement blocks, which will impede the free flow of traffic in Ras Khamis, Ras Shihadeh and Salam neighbourhood in Anata and Shofat refugee camp in Jerusalem.

#### **Raids:**

- On 02.09.2012, Israeli forces raided Al-Jeeb village and demolished a shelter, (i) levelled land belong to Al Shweeke family, then demolished a fence of a home that belongs to Samer Mabrooka under the pretext of building without permit.
- Home Demolition: On 09.02.2012, Israeli forces demolished a house in Beit Hanina neighbourhood belongs to Izz Abu-Nijma under the pretext of building without permit.

#### **Wall Gates:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on (ii) Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Oalandiya village; south of Al-Za'avvem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.

#### • Flying checkpoints: to search people and cars)

- (i) At 19:30, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the entrance of Imatten village.
- (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafer Lakef village.
- Raids: At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Elias village.
- <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces continued levelling lands in Kafer Qaddum village.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:20, a group of Israeli settlers entered lands north of Kafer Qaddum village.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.

#### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00
- (ii) At 05:00 Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.
- (iii) Between 09:20 and repeated at 20:35, Israeli forces restricted access at "Sheve Shomron" checkpoint.
- (iv) Between 16:00 16:30, Israeli forces closed Hwara checkpoint

#### • Flying checkpoints: to search people and cars)

- (i) At 12:00 and repeated at 07:10, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint near Deir Sharaf village junction.
- (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint on Al-Badan road.

#### Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from (ii) accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road (iii) east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a **BETHLEHEM** village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. Since 14:30 on 10.01.2012, Israeli forces continue to close the road (iv) leading to Kharba Baga and the road between Wadi Fukin and Jaba villages. (v) Israeli forces continues to close the Eastern entrance of Nahlin village, the road reaching to Al-Khader village, the road of Wadi Fukin, Zaatra road and between Tqwa and Kharba Al Deer village. Flying checkpoint: At 14:25, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint near Dar Salah, east of Beit Sahour (vi) (vii) At 15:15, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the entrance of Tqwah town. Raid: At 00:15 Israeli forces raided Beit Tammer village. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed northwest of Beit Jala town. **Closure:** The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq (i) Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-(i) Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling (ii) along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as (iii) detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to (iv) the entrance to Al-Simiya village. Hebron Since 09:40 on 10.01.2012, Israeli forces continued closing the entrance of (v) Beit Ammra with concrete blocks. Flying Checkpoints: (to search people and cars) (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Awa town. At 16:15, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the entrance of Faesh Al-Hawa. (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Younis. (iii) At 16:40 and repeated at 18:45, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the (iv)

Northern entrance of Hebron.

- (v) At 17:00, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at Ithna town junction.
- (vi) At 18:20, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the entrance of Ramaden village.

#### Raid:

- (i)At 11:20, Israeli forces raided Ithna town, searched a house and notified Ismael Al-Natah for security intelligence interrogation.
- (ii) At 14:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Fawar refugee camp and searched several homes.
- (iii)At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaka village, a confrontation took place between the residents of the villages and the Israeli forces.
- (iv)At 21:55, Israeli forces raided Deir Samet village.

#### • Detention:

- (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces detained 3 minors in the old city of Hebron: Nour Khalawe 14 years, Ammer Abu Hussain 14 years and Ibrahim Abu Ramoz 15 years.
- (ii)At 18:50, Israeli forces near the Ibrahimi mosque detained Ammen Salima under the pretext of carrying a knife.
- (iii)The detained in Al-Fawar refugee camp is: Hassan Abu Radwan.
- <u>Demonstration:</u> At 13:30, a demonstration took place in Dora town in solidarity with the Palestinian detainees.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.

NORTHERN GAZA	Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is opened for International workers, businessmen, and permitted health cases.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points:     Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.     Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	Closure of Crossing Points:  (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed.  (ii) Sufa Crossing is closed.  (iii) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is opened.  (vi) Al Awda crossing – Rafah was open for the exit of patients, students and passengers with permits.
