• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:** At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Thawri neighbourhood, stormed a home and summoned Rania Hatem to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.

• Detention:

- (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces detained Akram Sharfa (38 years old) near the entry gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Khaled Hassaneh (34 years old) and Ahmad Al-Obadi (25 years old) in Jerusalem for allegedly entering the city without a valid permit.
- (iii) At 20:20, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Jadou' (19 years old) and Mohammad Al-Asa (27 years old) {both residents of Bethlehem} for allegedly entering Jerusalem without a valid permit.
- Attack: At 07:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Nabi Saleh village fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:30, a group Israeli settler under the
 protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of
 Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Shawamra village until 12:30.
- (ii) At 01:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Obidiya area.
- Raid: At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and set up a checkpoint.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:30, Israeli settlers assaulted Fahim Hamad (27 years old) in Taqou'and pistol whipped his head leaving him hospitalised.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat

and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Awwa. And temporarily detained Faris Harbiyat.
- Raid: At 22:55, Israeli forces raided Sinjir area in Dura.
- Detention:
 - (i) At 09:00 on February 9th 2014, Israeli forces detained Hijazi Al-Qawasmi after storming his home in Hebron city.
 - (ii) At 12:25, Israeli forces detained Suliman Al-Hathalin (70 years old) near Um Al-Kheir area in south Yatta.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 19:45, an Israeli settler opened fire towards Al-Mizan Hotel in Hebron city and damaged several windows.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
