JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army prevented civilians from other districts from entering Jerusalem. The Israeli authorities continue to intensify restrictions on movement at the entrances of the city and its neighborhoods. • Separation Wall Construction: Construction of the separation wall in Al Eizariya, Abu Dis and Al Sawahira continues.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Separation Wall Construction: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Construction of the western portion of the separation wall in Budrus and Rantis continues. (ii) The Israeli army continues to erect barbed wire fence around the settlement of Huron on land belonging to the village of Beit Ur al Foqa, continuing north and west and separating the village of Saffa from Bil'in, and extending west towards the Green Line. (iii) Israeli bulldozers began leveling agricultural land along the Israeli settler bypass road in preparation for construction of the separation wall west of Beituniya. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Deir Al Sudan/Arura, searched vehicles and examined passenger IDs. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:05, the Israeli army raided the cities of Ramallah and El Bireh, patrolled the streets and searched 1 house. (ii) At 01:20, the Israeli army, supported by 4 jeeps, raided the town of Kafr 'Ein, searched 1 house and arrested 1 civilian. (iii) At 04:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Kharbatha Bani Harith and arrested 1 Palestinian Police officer. • Arrests: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army arrested Bilal Khalil in the town of Kafr 'Ein. (ii) The Israeli army arrested Ahmad Batlu, a Palestinian Police officer, in the village of Kharbatha Bani Harith.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. • Separation Wall Construction: Construction in the northern valleys

	<p>(Bardala, and 'Ein al Beida) and east of Tubas (Al Mutilla, Al Mughayyir, the outskirts of Raba, and Al Buqei' plateau) continues.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Silat ad Dhaher and opened fire towards civilians, injuring 1 civilian. (ii) At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin, searched 1 house and arrested the owner and his brother. (iii) At 03:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Sir, searched 1 house and arrested a Palestinian Police officer. • <u>Injury:</u> The Israeli army injured 14-year-old Wa'el Asba in the village of Silat ad Dhaher. • <u>Arrests:</u> <p>The Israeli army arrested 2 brothers in the city of Jenin:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Ayman Hassiss; and (ii) Nariman Hassiss. <p>The Israeli army arrested 1 civilian in the village of Sir:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) Bashar Irsheed, a Palestinian Police officer.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activities not yet reported.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The town of Al Walaja remains isolated due to the closure of the Beit Jala/Al Walaja road and the alternative dirt road by dirt and rock mounds, preventing access to health facilities and food supplies. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:50, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem and Ayda refugee camp. (ii) At 22:15, the Israeli army raided Ayda refugee camp.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Al Jarushiya, searched vehicles, examined passenger IDs and arrested 1 civilian. (ii) At 12:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Al Kafriyat, searched vehicles and arrested 1 civilian. (iii) At 21:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of the town of Attil, searched vehicles and examined passenger IDs. (iv) At 21:25, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Bal'a, searched vehicles and examined passenger IDs. (v) At 24:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the Shuweika road, searched vehicles and examined passenger IDs. • <u>Separation Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure

	<p>continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20, the Israeli army raided the towns of Beit Lid and Saffarin. (ii) At 16:30, the Israeli army raided the southern neighborhood of Tulkarem city, searched 1 house, and broke the windows of passing vehicles. At 05:10, the Israeli army arrested 4 civilians. (iii) At 22:00, the Israeli army raided Dahiyat Shuweika and patrolled the area. (iv) At 02:30, the Israeli army took position at the entrance of Tulkarem refugee camp and the entrance of Dahiyat Dhinnaba and opened indiscriminate fire towards civilian houses. (v) At 03:10, the Israeli army raided Tulkarem refugee camp and opened fire towards civilians. (vi) At 07:45, the Israeli army raided the town of Bal'a. • <u>Air Patrol:</u> At 15:00, Israeli helicopters and reconnaissance aircraft patrolled the skies over the city and its refugee camp. • <u>Arrests:</u> The Israeli army arrested: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Muhammad Haikal, at a flying checkpoint near Al Jarushiya; and (ii) Yunis Ibrahim, at a flying checkpoint near Al Kafriyat. The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians in the southern neighborhood of Tulkarem city: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) Yusif Al Barri, 50 years old; (iv) Raed Al Barri; (v) Mahmoud Mubarak; and (vi) Hamza Mubarak.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Arrest:</u> The Israeli army arrested Mariyam Abu Samara, a female college student, at the Beit Dajan checkpoint.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:00, several Israeli army jeeps raided the city of Hebron, occupied a building owned by the Islamic Charitable Society and converted the building into a military post. (ii) At 19:00, the Israeli army raided Al Arrub refugee camp, opened indiscriminate fire towards civilian houses and arrested 1 civilian. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:30, a group of Israeli settlers threw garbage at civilian houses in the old city of Hebron. (ii) At 18:30, an Israeli female settler verbally assaulted a Palestinian woman near the Ibrahim mosque. The Palestinian woman was arrested by the Israeli army following the incident.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army arrested Randa Al Fakhuri near the Ibrahimi Mosque. (ii) The Israeli army arrested Shadi Hammad in Al Arrub refugee camp.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 18:50, the Israeli army raided the village of Marda, imposed curfew, fired sound bombs and opened fire towards civilians.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Erez crossing was partially open to workers.
GAZA CITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The junction of Nitsareem remains closed. • Incursion: At 05:10, the Israeli army, supported by Israeli Special Forces, raided the area of Al Shuja'iyya, opened fire towards civilians and school students, prevented ambulances from reaching the area to provide medical assistance and transfer the injured to hospital. The Israeli army killed 10 civilians and injured 25, including 10 critical injuries. The Israeli army remains present in the area as of 08:00 this morning. • Attacks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:20, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from a watch tower near the mosque of Al Mighraqa towards Palestinian Territory. (ii) At 05:10, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from the settlement of Nehal Oz towards Palestinian Territory. • Raid: At 14:00, the Israeli army, including 3 Israeli jeeps, 1 tank and 1 bulldozer, entered Palestinian Territory 500 meters north of Wadi Gaza. • Killings: The Israeli army killed 10 civilians in Al Shuja'iyya, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Khaled Abu Irmana, a Palestinian officer; (ii) Hani Abu Sakhila; (iii) Muhammad Hillis; (iv) Mahdi Zeidiya; (v) Amir Al Ghamrawi; (vi) Haitham Abed; (vii) Ismael Abul Atta; (viii) Muhammad Al Ajala; and

CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activities not yet reported.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Abu al Ajin road (Khan Yunis Al Sharqiya) remains closed. (ii) Western road (Khan Yunis) remains closed. (iii) Abu Holi road is partially open (Closed at 16:50). (iv) Khan Yunis/Al Mawasi road remains closed. • Attack: At 18:30, the Israeli army, including 3 military trucks, 1 military personnel carrier, 1 bulldozer and jeeps, opened intensive fire while traveling from the settlement of Kissufim to the settlement of Morag.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Gaza International Airport remains closed. • Incursion: At 04:45, the Israeli army, supported by helicopters, raided and opened fire in the areas of Tel Zu'rob, Al Sha'out and the western part of Al Sha'out refugee camp, located near the Egyptian border at Point 9.5. The Israeli army killed 1 civilian and injured 10 others. The Israeli army remains present in Al Sha'out refugee camp as of 08:00 this morning. • Killing: The Israeli army killed Muhammad Zu'rob in Al Sha'out refugee camp.
