(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) At 08:30 on February 10th 2014, Israeli forces raided Anata and stormed several homes. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Rami Al-Dik (17 years old) in Al-Eizariya. (ii) On the evening of February 10th 2014, Israeli forces detained Yaysir Ajaj and Amir Darbas in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers stormed Ras Al-Amoud area in Jerusalem and demolished a home owned by Mohammad Hazilat. (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers stormed Al-Tur neighbourhood and demolished a storage den owned by Ali Al-Ju'ba. (iii) At 10:10, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers stormed Jabal Al-Mukabbir neighbourhood served several demolition orders for homes allegedly built without proper licencing. (iv) At 15:00, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers stormed Silwan and served a demolition order to Mohammad Al-Abbassi giving him 48 to evacuate his home for demolition for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:15 and again at 13:30, group Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> Israeli settlers stormed Silwan and slashed the tires of several vehicles and wrote racists graffiti on several vehicles. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Jaba', stormed several homes, summoned Tarik Alawneh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning and detained 3 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Ahmad Khalayleh (26 years old), Yasser Hamour (22 years old) and Hussien Khalayleh (26 years old) in Jab'a. • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces confiscated several cages with chicken from a farm owned by Mahmoud Mahajneh in Khirbeit Um A-Rihan village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ein Al-Bayda village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Tubas, stormed several homes, clashed with several residents, opened fire and launched tear gas grenades towards several residents and assaulted result injured 3 residents: Mohammad Al-Shamout (26 years old), Fadi Abdel Raziq (17 years old) and Ahmad Daraghmeh after detaining them . • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces stormed the north Jordan valley and served a demolition order to Musa Daraghmeh and Adib Al-Muslani to demolish their storage den. • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at Tayassir checkpoint confiscated a vehicle owned by Sa'id Basharat.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Far'un village, stormed 3 homes and prevented its residents from construction on the home for allegedly being too close to the wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 15:10, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Fuduq and Hajja villages. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. (ii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road connecting Beit Ummrin, Azba and Jallud villages. (iii) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road connecting Azzun, Al-Atma and Izbit Suliman villages. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.

(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 10:40, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Harris. BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Kuritash area located in North Bethlehem until 21:00. • Raid: At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and set up a checkpoint near Intercontinental Hotel. • Attack: At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Madaris area in Al-Khadr opened fire and fired tear gas grenades towards several residents until 15:44. • Settler Violence: At 22:25, an Israeli settler stormed agricultural land in Al-Khader in an attempt to confiscate 10 dunumes (acres) of land owned by Hassan Musa Hassan and damaged 150 Olive tree limbs and grape vines owned by Ayman Rayah. • Wall Construction: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
 - (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhul bridge.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces raided Yatta, stormed and searched a home in Al-Barka area.
 - (ii) At 20:00 and again at 23:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Thaer area in Beit Ummar then stormed and searched several homes.
 - (iii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Dura and stormed Billal Al-Roujubs home then withdrew at a later time.
 - (iv) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Wadi Al-Hariya area in Hebron and stormed students dorms in Polytechnic University.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near Khursa and Dura junction, fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- **Settler Violence:** At 12:20, Israeli settlers stormed and levelled agricultural land in east Yatta.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli air force broke the cease fire agreement launching missiles towards Gaza and Central Gaza.
