JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At dawn on February 10th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Samuel village, searched a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:000 on February 10th 2015, Israeli forces detained 2 residents including a child: Kathim Abu Sbieh (17 years old) and Majd Shqirat in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood. (ii) , Israeli forces detained Ahmad Barakat during their raid into Al-Nabi Samuel village. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces stormed Suwih area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem and demolished Mohammad Al-Abbassi’s home, during which they clashed with several residents who attempted to prevent the demolitions and Israeli forces served demolition orders for three homes in Al-Bustan area in Silwan for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 18:50 on January 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the area between Al-Mughier village and a by pas road and the main road between Al-Mughier and Duma villages with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:45, Israeli forces set up three checkpoints at Rawabi City junction and at the entrances of Um Safa and Al-Nabi Saleh villages until 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:40, Israeli forces raided Turmus’aya, clashed with several residents, detained a resident and temporarily detained Ahmad Abu Awad and released him later then withdrew at 22:35. (ii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Ramallah and Al-Bireh cities until 03:40. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Imad Shalabi in Turmus’aya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Arraba junction until 12:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:25, Israeli forces raided Arraba, stormed a merchant shop then withdrew at 16:25. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Ra’i. (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Jaba’, stormed four homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:00. (iv) At 04:10, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:00. (v) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Markah village, stormed several homes, detained five residents then withdrew at 07:00. (vi) At 05:00, Israeli forces raided Jenin camp. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Sa’ed Hamarah in Jaba’. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ali Asfour in Ya’bad. (iii) Israeli forces detained five residents: Salah Musa, Mahmoud Musa, Murad Musa, Raed Musa and Bashir Musa in Markah village. • <u>Provocation of Palestinian Security Forces:</u> At 11:35, Israeli forces positioned near Anza village junction prevented a Palestinian Police vehicle from performing its security duties (despite having prior coordination) as it was travelling from Anza junction to Silat Al-Thaher.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 15:40, Israeli forces raided Bardala village detonated an Israeli Military explosive device then withdrew at 16:30.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:0, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv”

	checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:00.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Baqat Al-Hatab village, temporarily detained several residents and released them later then withdrew at 11:00. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Azzun and Izbit Al-Tabib village until 22:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Hajja village, clashed with several residents as they stormed a merchant shop and as a result damaged several products then withdrew at 13:20. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Azzun (for an alleged stoning incident), clashed with several residents then withdrew at 22:20. (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Eliyas village. (iv) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Thulth until 05:20. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:05, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwarah checkpoint until 14:20. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beita until 11:05. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Usirin village junction until 14:20. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Salem village until 01:15.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 11:35, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:40. • Raid: At 16:10, Israeli forces raided Bruqin, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 16:40. • Land Levelling: At 08:25, Israeli forces levelled a plot of land near the entrance of "Arial" settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at road (90) junction near Al-Nuwe'meh village in north Jericho until 09:50. • Raid: At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Jericho until 02:25. • Temporary Detention: At 11:10, Israeli forces positioned at "Al-Hamra" checkpoint temporarily detained three Palestinian Police Officer: Amjad Al-Masri, Mohammad Abu Al-Hijeh and Jamal Abu Aun then released them at 11:35.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Abu Al-Asja village. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Sammit village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp then stormed and searched three homes. (ii) At dawn on February 11th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with several residents as the stormed several homes and as a result injured Ahmad Awad and detained seven residents including two children. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces detained the child: Yazan Haribat (17 years old) as he was walking near the wall gate located in Beit Roush Al-Foqa village. (ii) Israeli forces detained seven residents including two children: Isam Bahar (16 years old), Ameer Khalil (16 years old), Mazen Awad, Mohammad Khalil, Ibrahim Abu Daya, Mahmoud Khalil and Mohammad Khalil in Beit Ummar. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Ala Hamidat then released him later. • <u>Land Confiscation:</u>

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • The Israeli military broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza and as a result injured a resident.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Detention: On February 10th 2015, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Hanun (Erez) crossing detained Husam Nur Al-Din (a merchant) {a resident of Gaza}.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: On February 10th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards a resident in east Al-Maghazi camp and as a result injured him.

(ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
