JERUSALEM	Closure:  (i) Since January 6th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.  (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.  Closure of Main Roads:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.  (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.  Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.  Flying Checkpoints: At 11:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Beit Qaddu and Beit Ijza.  Wall Gates:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.  Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim because of Sabbath holiday.

The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the (ii) village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended in Kafr Lagef village north of Karne Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement for Sabbath holidays. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-(i) Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the (ii)southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. **Checkpoints:** (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Mount Jerzim) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it **NABLUS** is open between 07:00 and, 02:00 At 05:00 Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross (ii)between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and

The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Danivyel" (i) settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Tagou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.

# **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 21:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the western entrance to Taguo.
- (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Za'tara.

#### Raids:

- On the evening of February 10<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces raided Harmalah and (i) detained 5 residents including 3 siblings.
- At 10:55, Israeli forces raided Um Al Rakaba area in Al Khadir. (ii)
- (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Al Ubeidiya.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Marwan Al Zir, Kamal Al Zir, Mo'ath Al Zir, Mujahid Al Zir, and Khalid Al Zir during their raid into Harmalah.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended northwest of Beit Jala town because of Sabbath holiday.

## **Closure:**

- The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq (i) Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the (ii) Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

### **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as (iii) detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to (iv) the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
- Since 09:40 on 10.01.2012, Israeli forces continued closing the entrance of (v) Beit Amra with concrete blocks.

# **Flying Checkpoints:**

- (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Targumiya.
- (ii) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al Ramadin village.

### Raids:

At 10:00 and again at 23:55, Israeli forces raided Al Thahiriya, searched (i) several homes, and withdrew at 03:30.

# **HEBRON**

(ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Dura.

### • Physical Assault:

- (i) At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron, assaulted and injured Mofid Al Sharaba'i leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- (ii) At 16:55, Israeli forces positioned near eastern Hebron assaulted Nidal Massoda leaving hospitalised with contusions.

# • Demonstrations:

- (i) At 12:00, Palestinian and International peace activists marched towards Suissa village protesting against settler violence, land confiscation and the prevention of local residents from farming their land. During which protesters managed to remove a wire fence placed by Israeli forces and clashed with Israeli forces leaving 8 protestors injured after being physically assaulted. Israeli forces also detained a resident and a demonstrator.
- (ii) At 14:00, Palestinian and International peace activists marched towards Beit Ummar protesting settler violence and the prevention of Palestinian farmers from reaching their land. During which protesters clashed with Israeli forces which fired tear gas grenades leaving several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation and detained2 residents after physically assaulting and injuring a demonstrators leaving him hospitalised with contusions. Israeli forces also detained 2 international activists.

#### • Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Taw'aj'a during demonstrations in Yatta.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Yousef Abu Maria and Saqer Abu Maria during demonstrations in Beit Ummar.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town because of Sabbath holiday.
