<p style="text-align: center;"><b>ALL DISTRICTS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.</li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>JERUSALEM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <p><b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and prevent civilians from accessing the mosque, only allowing access to female civilians and civilians holding Israeli-issued IDs who are above 45 years of age. This Israeli measure aims to prevent civilian demonstrations against the Israeli army's levelling of Bab al Maghariba old road, which leads to Al Aqsa Mosque compound.</p> </li> <li> <p><b>Closure of Main Roads:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.</li> </ul> </li> <li> <p><b>Checkpoint:</b> The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.</p> </li> <li> <p><b>Wall Gates:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> <li> <p><b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.</p> </li> <li> <p><b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Beit Iksa and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Attack/School Disruption:</u></b> The Israeli army opened fire towards civilians in At Tur and Al Mukabbir Mount neighbourhoods in the city of Jerusalem, claiming that a number of children threw stones at Israeli army patrols in protest against land levelling near Bab al Maghariba leading to Al Aqsa Mosque compound. In addition, the Israeli army arrested 3 civilians. After stones were thrown at an Israeli settler vehicle, the Israeli army raided a school in At Tur neighbourhood.</li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the city of Jerusalem:       <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Jihad Mousa al 'Ajlouni;</li> <li>(ii) Samer al Mhalwes; and</li> <li>(iii) Mohammed Hasan ash Shiki.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 02:00, the Israeli army raided Qalandiya refugee camp, searched 2 houses, and withdrew at 02:30.</li> <li>• <b><u>Demonstration:</u></b> At 14:30, a mass demonstration took place in the village of Qatanna in protest against the Israeli army's land levelling near Bab al Maghariba leading to Al Aqsa Mosque compound. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and protestors.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>RAMALLAH &amp; EL BIREH</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede access to the city of Ramallah for civilians under 35 years of age who hold IDs issued in the northern districts of the West Bank.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of 'Abud, in the areas of Al Midya to Ni'lin, Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis, and in the town of Beituniya.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids/House Occupation:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 00:35, the Israeli army, including 13 jeeps, raided the city of Ramallah, occupied the roof of a building, and converted it into a military post. The Israeli army also searched another building and withdrew at 04:20.</li> <li>(ii) At 01:40, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of El Bireh.</li> <li>(iii) At 02:30, the Israeli army, including 13 jeeps, raided the city of El Bireh and Al Am'ari refugee camp. In the refugee camp, the Israeli army searched 1 house and arrested 1 civilian. At 03:10, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> At 20:10, the Israeli army arrested 2 civilians, including 1 child, at the entrance to the village of Deir Abu Mash'al, while they were throwing stones at Israeli settler vehicles:       <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Hasan al Barghouthi, 17 years old; and</li> <li>(ii) Ad'ham Kheir al Barghouthi.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army arrested Mohammed Sa'eed Ramadhan in Al Am'ari refugee camp.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>

<b>JENIN</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Roads:</b> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan as well as the road connecting the town of Qabatiya to the village of Misliya.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoint:</b> The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one in the area between the town of ‘Arraba and the village of Mirka and the other at the entrance to the village of Al Jarba, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town of Tammun and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Raids/Physical Assault/Attack:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 12:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Tammun. An Israeli army jeep ran over Maysoun Hasan Bani ‘Odeh, a female civilian, leaving her with contusions. Maysoun was transported to Nablus Public Hospital for medical treatment. At 24:00, the Israeli army raided the town again and opened fire, while patrolling the area.</li> <li>(ii) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided the town of As Silat al Harithiya, set up a checkpoint at its entrance, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area.</li> <li>(iii) At 24:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin and patrolled the area until 02:30.</li> <li>(iv) At 01:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Tubas.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>TULKAREM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district.</li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal’a road, the entrance to the village of Saffarin, the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to ‘Attil plain, and the road connecting the town of Kafr al Labad to the village of Shufa.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city).</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at ‘Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city of Tulkarem) and prevented civilians under 30 years of age from leaving the city.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint/Physical Assault:</b> At 08:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint along the road to the plain of the village of Ramin, searched civilians and vehicles, and beat Nihad Abdul Rahman Qa’dan.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Raids/Attack/Destruction of Property:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At dawn on 12 February 2007, the Israeli army raided the town of Deir al Ghusun and arrested 1 civilian.</li> <li>(ii) At 02:40 on 12 February 2007, the Israeli army raided Dahiyat Shuweika in the city of Tulkarem and arrested 1 civilian.</li> <li>(iii) At 18:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem and arrested 1 Palestinian National Security officer.</li> <li>(iv) At 23:15, the Israeli army raided the village of Far'un. While patrolling the area, the Israeli army opened fire and fired sound grenades.</li> <li>(v) At 00:45, the Israeli army raided Dahiyat Shuweika in the city of Tulkarem and used explosives to destroy the doors of a number of commercial shops in order to search them. At 03:45, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 03:40 on 12 February 2007, the Israeli army arrested Raed Kheiri 'Awwad during its raid into the town of Bal'a, in addition to those reported yesterday.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army arrested Thaer Mohammed Rabay'ah in the town of Deir al Ghusun.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army arrested 'Issam Rasmi Dhmeiri in Dahiyat Shuweika in the city of Tulkarem.</li> <li>(iv) The Israeli army arrested Muhannad Ali al Jaroushi in the city of Tulkarem.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>QALQILIYA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army closed Wall gate # 25 in the area south of the town of Jayyus and redirected farmers' access to another gate located north of the town.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul>
<b>NABLUS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. The Israeli army only allows civilian vehicles possessing access permits to cross these checkpoints. The Israeli army also searches civilians using metal detectors at Beit Iba checkpoint, impeding their access.</li> <li>(ii) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only.</li> <li>(iii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30.</li> <li>(iv) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 12:35, the Israeli army raided the village of Till and searched 1 house.</li> <li>(ii) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus, 'Ein Beit el Ma' refugee camp, and the villages of Salim and Till, searched a number of houses, arrested 3 civilians, and withdrew at 06:00.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Arrests:</b> The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the city of Nablus, 'Ein Beit el Ma' refugee camp, as well as in the villages of Salim and Till: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) 'Amer Na'im as Sukraji;</li> <li>(ii) Mohammed Salem Abu Thra'; and</li> <li>(iii) Yousef Fawzi Abu ar Reesh.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> </ul>
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising).</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za'tara junction checkpoint and to impede civilian access. At 09:00, Israeli troops positioned at the checkpoint denied access to civilians under 35 years of age.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Bruqin and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Kafr ad Dik. While patrolling the area, confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians. At 20:45, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>JERICHO</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoint:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at Al Hamra checkpoint set up along Al Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al 'Auja along Al Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.</li> <li>• <b>Raid/Attack:</b> At 01:50, the Israeli army, including 8 jeeps, raided 'Aqbat Jaber refugee camp in the city of Jericho and opened fire, while searching 1 house. At 03:10, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>BETHLEHEM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, northwest of the city of Beit Jala, and in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Efrat.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> At 10:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint along Wadi an Nar road connecting the town of Al 'Ubeidiya to the village of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, searched civilians and vehicles, and arrested 3 civilians.</li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 09:00, Israeli Special Forces raided the city of Bethlehem and arrested 1 child.</li> <li>(ii) At 13:50, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Beit Jala and arrested 1 child.</li> <li>(iii) At 19:00, an Israeli army patrol raided Al 'Aza refugee camp in the city of Bethlehem and patrolled the area.</li> <li>(iv) At 01:00, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided the town of Al 'Ubeidiya, searched 1 house, and withdrew at 02:00.</li> <li>(v) The Israeli army raided the town of Al Khadr and arrested 1 civilian.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Arrests:</b> Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up along Wadi an Nar road arrested 3 civilians: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Mousa Ahmed Rabay'ah;</li> <li>(ii) Mahmoud Abu Hammad; and</li> <li>(iii) Jamil Ibrahim al 'Assa.</li> <li>(iv) Israeli Special Forces troops arrested Hamzeh Omar Hamadeh, 16 years old, in the city of Bethlehem.</li> <li>(v) The Israeli army arrested Khader Hanna al Hussein, 16 years old, in the city of Beit Jala.</li> <li>(vi) The Israeli army arrested Yousef Hasan Salah in the town of Al Khadr.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

## HEBRON

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh.
  - (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of Al Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp.
  - (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.
- **Attack/Injuries:** At 16:00, Israeli troops positioned at the entrance to the town of Beit Ummar opened fire towards civilians, allegedly for throwing stones. The Israeli attack resulted in the injury of 2 civilians, including 1 child.
- **Raids/Air Patrol:**
  - (i) At 14:50, and again at 01:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron.
  - (ii) At 19:00, Israeli troops, dispatched by an Israeli combat helicopter, raided and combed the area of Al Jalajil between the towns of Taffuh and Dura.
  - (iii) At 00:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Idhna.
- **Arrests/Physical Assaults:** The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians (brothers) in the old city of Hebron, after having beaten them:
  - (i) 'Antar Anwar al Barad'i; and
  - (ii) Adham Anwar al Barad'i.



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Land Levelling:</u></b> At 13:30, the Israeli army began levelling a piece of land, measuring 400 square metres, in the area of Farsh al Hawa north of the city of Hebron in order to construct a military watchtower.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settlement Activity:</u></b> The Israeli army began constructing a ceiling over Al Khan Market in the old city of Hebron.
