TUBAS	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00. <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Tubas until 03:00.
	Attack: On February 12 th 2012 Israeli forces positioned near Al Farisiya village opened fire at residential homes.
TULKAREM	Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr

- Al-Labad town to Shufa village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.
- <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army increased restrictions on Palestinian access at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Bal'a village junction.
- (ii) At 22:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Kafin junction, detained a resident and temporarily detained Walid Sabah releasing him at a later time.

• Raids:

- (i) At 14:15, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, detained and questioned several residents then withdrew at 16:30.
- (ii) At 21:45, Israeli forces raided Al Shuweika neighbourhood in Tulkarem and clashed with residents
- **Detention:** Israeli forces positioned at Fuqin junction detained Ahmad Sabah.
- <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.

• Closure of Roads:

- (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.
- (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 14:55 and again at 21:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Qalqilya, detained Nimer Assad, Mohammad Daloul and Mohammad Hilal and released them at 23:35.
- (ii) At 22:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Hajja and Baqat Al Hatab villages.

• Raids:

- (i) At 09:30 and again at 01:30, Israeli forces raided Qalqilya, stormed a home and a merchant shop, summoned Ayman Ju'eidi and Mohammad Anaya to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning, temporarily detained and questioned several residents, searched several homes and detained 3 residents.
- (ii) At 14:55, Israeli forces raided Izbat Al Tabib village, stormed a carpentry shop, temporalarly detained and questioned several workers and realised them at a later time.
- (iii) At 16:10, Israeli forces raided Azzun.
- (iv) At 20:50, Israeli forces raided Baqat Al Hatab village and detained 3 police officers and released them after security coordination.
- (v) At 22:05, Israeli forces raided Jit village.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained, Rabi' Nassar, Samih Nassar and Walid Sweilem during their raid into Qalqilya.
- <u>Physical Assault:</u> As mentioned in the previous report, at 05:45, Israeli physically assaulted and injured Mohammad Jaber, a security officer during their raid into Jayyus.

QALQILYA

• Confiscation of Property:

As mentioned in the previous report, at 05:45 on February 12th 2012, Israeli forces seized a computer and a cellular telephone.

- *Israeli forces also seized a cellular phone as they raided Nader Khrieshas home.
- *Israeli forces seized a computer and cellular phone as they raided Omar Mahmoud home.
- *Israeli forces seized a computer, 3 cellular phones and damaged the front door as they raided Mohammad Jabers home.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqef village north of Karne Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Oarvut.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Mount Jerzim) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00
- (ii) At 05:00 Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.
- (iii) At 08:30, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (iv) At 21:20, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at "Shave Shomron" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:30.

NABLUS

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Sarah village junction.
- (ii) At 09:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Beir Farouk junction until 13:00.
- (iii) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction.
- (iv) At 13:20 and again at 17:35, Israeli force set up a flying checkpoint At Yassid village and Beit Imrin village junctions.
- (v) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at "Yitsahar" settlement junction.
- (vi) At 17:05, Isareli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Nablus and Asira Al Shamaliya.

• Raids:

(i) At 09:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Imrin village.

(vii)At 05:05, Israeli forces raided Askar camp in Nablus, positioned near Palestinian security force headquarters, aimed their weapons at several Palestinian security officers and withdrew at 05:20. Settler Violence: (i) At 17:45, a group of Israeli settlers raided the area near Bsheer Al Zins home and withdrew at 18:30. (ii) At 21:15, a group of Israeli settlers raided the area near Huwara checkpoint and provoked and slandered residents then withdrew at 22:00.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to increase restrictions on access at the Za'tara checkpoint and impedes the free flow of traffic. Flying Checkpoints: At 18:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Kafil Harres until 19:00. At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Deir Istiya junction until 23:00. Raid: At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al Dik, stormed a home and withdrew at 18:35. At 19:45, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya, fired stun grenades and withdrew at 22:40. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. Checkpoints: (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley. (ii) Israeli forces continue restrict access at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. Flying Checkpoint: (i) At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho. (ii) At 20:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al Nabi Musa area junction on the main road connecting Jericho and Jerusalem. Detention: On February 11 2012, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Daud Akram, a resident of Nablus and his wife as they were travelling to Jordan.

Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from (ii) accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road (i) between Um Tuba and Al-Jass: a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" (ii) settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara **BETHLEHEM** and a detour road, and a road between Tagou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. At 14:00, the Israeli army closed the road leading to Al Fardous village with (iii) dirt mounds and cement blocks. Checkpoint: At 08:00, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at Container checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. Flying Checkpoint: At 21:05, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of Beit Jala and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:15. Raids: At 16:15, Israeli forces raided Al Shuwarat village until 16:30. (i) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Al Asakra village. (ii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Al Aydah camp, stormed a (iii) home and summoned Mohammad Al Badan, to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. At 03:50, Israeli forces raided Hussan village and detained a resident. (iv) Detention: Israeli forces detained Mohammad Hamamra (16 years) during their raid into Hussan village. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed northwest of Beit Jala town. The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq (i) Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-(i) Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil **HEBRON** villages. The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling

(ii)

- along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
- (v) Since 09:40 on 10.01.2012, Israeli forces continued closing the entrance of Beit Amra with concrete blocks.
- Flying Checkpoints: At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.

• Raids:

- (i) At 11:20, Isareli forces raided Al Munthar area in Yatta, stormed the home of Ahmad Abu Zahra, damaged furniture and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Al Tabaqa village, clashed with residents, injured Mahmoud Matar and detained 3 residents.
- (iii) At 13:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron and set up a flying checkpoint.
- (iv) At 16:35, Israeli forces raided Al Fawwar camp, clashed with residents and detained 2 minors.
- (v) At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, searched a home and detained a resident.

• Detention:

- (i) At 16:15, Israeli forces detained Ayman Al Joulani, a preventive security officer in the old city of Hebron,
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Aladdin Abu Zahra during their raid into Yatta.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Oday Hrebat, Mo'tasim Abu Za'toun and Mohammad Shanan during their raid into Al Tabaqa village.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Al Teti (15 years) and Mohammad Al Aza (16 years) during their raid into Fawwar camp.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Adham Oday during their raid into Beit Ummar.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 12:25, a group of Israeli settlers raided the area between Hebron and Bani Na'im and planted trees on Palestinian owned land.
- (ii) On the evening of February 12th 2012, a group of Israeli settlers stoned vehicles passing through the old city of Hebron and damaged Hashima Al Takrouries vehicle.
- <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 08:00, family members of detainees marched towards "Me tar" checkpoint located south of Al Thahiriya protesting Israeli authorities policy of strip searching detainee visitors in Israeli prisons, in solidarity with detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into

effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at ALL 22:00. **DISTRICTS** On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. **Detention:** At 07:10, Israeli forces detained 2 Palestinian fishermen, Jamal Sultan **NORTHERN** and Fadil Sultan and seized their fishing boat after apprehending them at the shores **GAZA** of Beit Lahiya. **Temporary Detention:** At 17:40, Israeli forces temporarily detained 2 fishermen, Mahmoud Abu Rayala (14 years) and Adham Abu Rayala after apprehending them at the shores of Beit Lahiya and released them at 01:30 **Closure of Crossing Points:** Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the (i) Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. GAZA (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for critical patients, students and residents (ii) with special permits. Sufa Crossing is closed. (iii) **RAFAH** Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the (iv) transportation of food supplies, goods, humanitarian aid, cooking gas, 23 truckloads of livestock feed, construction cargo designated to internationally funded projects were allowed through while 1 shipment of flowers was allowed through for export. .
