	(i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa
	 mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local
	 residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.
	Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.

	 (ii) At 15:10, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, temporarily detained Mohammad Al-Nada (12 years old) near his home then released him later.
	(iii) At 19:25, Israeli forces raided Turmus'aya, clashed with several residents during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades then withdrew 19:35.
	 <u>Attack:</u> At 14:15, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Um Al-Sharayet fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. <u>Detention</u>: Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Ras Kar Kar detained Fadi Qadah (25 years old) {A resident of Qibiya}.

(iii) At 17:30 and again at dawn on February 13th 2015, Israeli forces raided Zabuba village located in west Jenin, stormed several homes, clashed with residents and fired stun and tear gas grenades towards them and as a result left several of them suffocated from tear gas inhalation and then installed a checkpoint at its entrance.
	 <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village.

	• <u>Wall Gates:</u>
	(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate
	and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close
	with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to
	deny civilian access.
	(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109.
	Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the
	Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the
	village through the Habla gate.
	• <u>Closure</u> : Since December 17 th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500
	dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.
	<u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-
	Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the
	settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the
	village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the
	village of Osrin.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the
	southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and
	Qaryut.
	• Checkpoint: At 11:45, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara
	checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:30.

	Nablus city then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces.
	<u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two
	detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
	(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city
	to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from
SALFIT	08:00 until 09:20.
	(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30 th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to
	Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with
	cement blocks.
	(iv) Since January 21 st 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Deir Istiya

	with dirt mounds.			
	• <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara			
	• <u>Checkpoints</u> : Islaen forces continue to intensity their restrictions at Za tara checkpoint and imped the free flow of traffic.			
JERICHO	 <u>Checkpoints</u>: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. <u>Flying Checkpoint</u>: At 18:00, at 18:33 and again at 03:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 03:35. <u>Raid</u>: At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Jericho until 01:50. 			
	Closure:			
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.			
	 Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. 			
	<u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>			
BETHLEHEM	 (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita 			
	Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.			
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.			
	 (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. 			
	(v) Since June 3 rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.			
	(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29 th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.			
	(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.			
	 (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. 			
	• <u>Raid:</u> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Nihalin, stormed Yusef Shaqarneh's home, fired stun and tear gas grenades as they clashed with residents then withdrew at 14:00.			
	(ii) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem.

	 <u>Closure:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat
	and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
HEBRON	 Flying Checkpoint: (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction until 09:53. (ii) At 10:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Kahil until 10:53. (iii) At 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Hahul bride until 19:10. (iv) At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Urub camp until 19:33. (v) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sa'ir until 10:22.
	 <u>Raid:</u> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 10:55. (ii) At 11:20, Israeli forces raided Jabal Abu Ram area in Hebron, stormed a merchant shop owned by Hani Abu Aisheh then withdrew at 11:55. <u>Attack:</u> At 21:10, Israeli forces opened fire towards a vehicle near Al-Baraka area in Yatta as they chased it and as a result damaged the vehicle as it crashed. <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 16:30, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Sa'ir located near "Mistat Asfar" settlement and uprooted 70 Olive trees owned by Bassam Shaladeh.

RAFAH	 <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
