| JERUSALEM | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <p><b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and prevent civilians from accessing the mosque, only allowing access to female civilians and civilians holding Israeli-issued IDs who are above 45 years of age. This Israeli measure aims to prevent civilian demonstrations against the Israeli army's levelling of Bab al Maghariba old road, which leads to Al Aqsa Mosque compound.</p> </li> <li> <p><b>Closure of Main Roads:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.</li> </ul> </li> <li> <p><b>Checkpoint:</b> The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.</p> </li> <li> <p><b>Wall Gates:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> <li> <p><b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.</p> </li> </ul> |

The Israeli army only allows civilian vehicles possessing access permits to cross these checkpoints. | <b>HEBRON</b>    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh.</li> <li>(ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of Al Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp.</li> </ol> </li> </ul> |

- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.
  - **Flying Checkpoint:** At 10:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Idhna and searched civilians and vehicles.
  - **Raids:**
    - (i) At dawn on 13 February 2007, the Israeli army raided the village of Kharsa and arrested 6 civilians, including 2 children.
    - (ii) At dawn on 13 February 2007, the Israeli army raided the town of Dura and arrested 1 civilian.
    - (iii) At 24:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron.
  - **Arrests:**
    - (i) At 00:50 on 13 February 2007, the Israeli army arrested Mahmoud Abdullah Faraj Allah during its raid into the town of Idhna.

At 01:20 on 13 February 2007, the Israeli army arrested 3 civilians during its raid into the city of Hebron:

    - (ii) Abdul 'Atheem Jamil an Natsheh;
    - (iii) Sameer Abdul Haleem Dweik; and
    - (iv) 'Adnan Abdul Majeed Abu Tabbaneh.

At 18:00, the Israeli army arrested 3 civilians, including 2 children, while they were tending sheep near the Wall in the vicinity of the town of Beit 'Awwa:

    - (v) Mu'ath Abdul Majeed al Qahoush, 15 years old;
    - (vi) Ahmed 'Ayed as Suweiti, 15 years old; and
    - (vii) Khaled Ibrahim as Suweiti.

The Israeli army arrested 6 civilians in the village of Kharsa:

    - (viii) Isma'il az Zabadi, 17 years old;
    - (ix) Nidhal Shiblein az Zabadi, 17 years old;
    - (x) Salem Abdul Jaleel ash Shahatit;
    - (xi) Yousef Abdul Jaleel ash Shahatit;
    - (xii) Rami Ahmed Mahmoud; and
    - (xiii) Samer Mohammed ash Shahatit.
    - (xiv) The Israeli army arrested Mohammed Younes ar Rjoub in the town of Dura.
  - **Settler Violence:** At 15:30, a group of Israeli settlers raided the village of Khirbet Salama in an attempt to assault civilian residents. Consequently, the Israeli army forced the settlers out of the village.
