ALL DISTRICTS	 At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis.
NORTHERN GAZA	 <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. <u>Raid</u>: On the morning of February 14th 2013, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers stormed 300 meters into the vicinity Abu Samara area Beit Lahiya and opened fire as they levelled a plot of land,
GAZA	 <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
KHAN YUNIS	• <u>Attack:</u> On the morning of February 12 th 2013, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards several farmers as they were heading towards their farm land located near the border fence in Al-Qarara.
