### **WEST BANK**

### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

### • Checkpoints:

### **JERUSALEM**

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 16:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:00.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- <u>Detention</u>: On the evening of February 20<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces detained Ameer AlFaroukh (14 years old) in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 18:40, Israeli forces stormed Al-Da'wat mosque in Beit Hanina during evening prayers, searched the mosque and forcibly removed worshipers from the mosque.

### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

# RAMALLAH & AL BIREH

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- **Raids:** At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Ramallah and detained a resident.
- Attack: At 18:10, Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards several residents in Al-Jalazoun camp for alleged stoning
- <u>Killing:</u> On February 20<sup>th</sup> 2013, Rami Al-Talib died of injuries sustained from Israeli live ammunition on October 20<sup>th</sup> 2000.

### **QALQILIYA**

- (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 17:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jayyus.
- **<u>Raid:</u>** At 14:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Elisa's village and prevented a resident from operating water pump to pump water from his water well.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Dawood Dawood in Qalqiliya
- Attack: At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun fired tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning

### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

### • Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
- (ii) On January 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces levelled residential land located at the eastern entrance of Azzun Atma for the purpose of constructing the Wall in the area.
- (iii) On February 6<sup>th</sup> 2013 Israeli military bulldozers levelled residential land in Jayyus for the purpose of Wall construction.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Oarvut.

### • Raid:

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Jallud, took photographs of several old homes then withdrew at 08:30.
- (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Qusra village, uprooted several electrical poles which supply the village with electricity in order to allow a settlement outpost "Majdolin"in the area and as a result leaving most of the village residents without electricity during which Israeli forces stormed the village and fired tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent Israeli forces from removing the electrical poles and injured Odwan Odeh with head wounds and detained a child.
- (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Hatab until 16:30.
- (iv) At 17:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq and clashed with its residents.
- (v) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Nablus as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed Josephs tomb, clashed with residents then withdrew at 02:05.

### Attack

- (i) At 09:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and prevented vehicles from entering or exiting the camp after closing the steel gate entrance then reopened it at later time.
- (ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation and detained a resident.
- (iii) At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Fuwar camp fired tear gas grenades towards residents inside the camp for alleged stoning.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Mohammad Sabarna in Beit Ummar.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 17:40, several Israeli settlers assaulted and injured Nael Abu Arram as he was herding his sheep near "Metsi Yair" settlement leaving him hospitalised with contusions.

### • Demonstration:

- (i) At 11:00, demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Hebron in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
- (ii) At 12:00, a demonstration took place in Yatta in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

### **GAZA STRIP**

# At 21:00 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles. Israeli Forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards Khan Yunis.
