WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 23:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata until 01:15.
- Raid: At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and clashed with several residents.

• Detention:

- (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Absate gate (A gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city Jerusalem detained Mohammad Abu Al-Humus (A resident of Al-Eisawiya).
- (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces detained Sami Abu Khdeir (15 years old) {A resident of Shu'fat camp}.
- (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near the Jerusalem Municipality building in Jerusalem detained Mahmoud Shar'iya (A resident of Bir Zeit) {after he allegedly stabbed an Israeli settler}.

Attack:

- (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Kasrat area located near Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) On the evening of February 22nd 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Silwan neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets and stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- Physical Assault: At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Majlis gate A

- (i) At 09:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Asakra village until 09:15.
- (ii) At 17:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata.

• Raid:

- (i) At 19:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, clashed with several residents after storming several homes and as a result injured 5 residents including a child: Ali Al-Azat (17 years old), Issa Abu Srour, Mohammad Bedawneh, Mu'tasim Abu Khdeir and Ahmad Al-Adawin and also assaulted 4 residents: Nabhan Nasrallah, Du'a Al-Dibis, Mustafa Abu Srour and Ziyad Aliyan and as a result left them hospitalised with contusions then withdrew at 22:40.
- (ii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, detained a National Security Force officer and summoned Ahmad Abiyat to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ali Salihat (a National Security Force officer) in Bethlehem.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sa'ir until 10:20.
- (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Awa until 17:45.
- (iii)At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge.
- (iv)At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction.
- (v) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Urub camp until 20:55.
- (vi)At 22:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Abu Snieneh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron until 23:00.

• Raid:

- (i) At 09:10 and again at dawn on February 23rd 2015, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed several homes, detained a resident, and summoned four residents: Sa'ed Abu Eisheh, Qusay Fakhouri, Khaldoun Al-Ajlouni and Billal Abdel-Aziz to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then detained two other residents after storming their home (Total detained 3 residents).
- (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya, summoned 4 residents: Ta'at Abu Allan, Saleh Abu Allan, Adib Abu Allan and Ibrahim Al-Hawarin to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
- (iii)At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Dura and summoned Mahmoud Abu Ras to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained three residents: Firas Al-Rajabi, Mohammad Shawar and Ahmad Shawar in Hebron.

HEBRON

At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the **ALL** fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by **DISTRICTS** the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Rafah. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical **NORTHERN** patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad **GAZA** through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **GAZA** (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and **RAFAH** foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA. Attack: On the morning of February 22nd 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several farmers located near Sufa

Crossing in North East Rafah city.
