- (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

# • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

# • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 16:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:00.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

# • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Anata junction.
- (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khan Al-Humra area along the road connecting Jerusalem and Jericho.
- Raid: At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village and clashed with residents as they stormed several homes.

(i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and injured Fadi Bajhtan. (ii) At 00:50, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and injured a resident. **Demonstrations:** At 13:50, a demonstration took place in Al-Isawiya in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons and clashed with Israeli forces who detained 6 residents. **Detention:** (i) At 00:50, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint detained Amir Abu Thahir and Jallal Abu Usba'. (ii) Israeli forces detained Alla Al-Hadad, Ihab Za'ier, Ashraf Al-Zurba, Mohammad Al-Hadad, Hamza Al-Za'ir and Mohammad Halaq in Al-Isawiya village. **Wall Gates:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in (i) Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim for Sabbath holiday. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. Flying Checkpoint: At 12:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atra bridge. Attack: (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets towards several residents for alleged stoning and injured Mamoud Mukhmas (15 years old). (ii) On February 23<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces positioned near Aboud fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for RAMALLAH & alleged stoning and injured 4 residents including 2 critically injured: AL BIREH Mohammad Asfour, Nijim Al-Barghouthi, Omar Abdel Qadr and Ehab Al-Barghouthi. **Detention:** At 12:25, Israeli forces positioned near Ofar prison detained Sa'ed Hamad, a resident of Silwad. **Demonstration:** At 17:55, demonstration took place in Ramallah in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and in protest against the killing of Arafat Jaradat (A Palestinian detainee who died while being interrogated by Israeli forces in Majdio Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages. **Closure of Main Road:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. **JENIN** (ii) Since the evening of November 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. - (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) On December 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in south Yatta and prevented members of Al-Shamsati family rom entering their agricultural land and detained a resident.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 17:30 and again at 13:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 15:30.
- (ii) At 13:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, temporarily detained 4 residents: Badr Ikhlil, Wajih Ikhlil, Yusef Ikhlil and Mohammad Ikhlil releasing them at a later time.

## • Attack:

- (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar, fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged firebombing of an Israeli military jeep.
- (iii) At 22:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Sa'ir fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.

# • Detention:

- (i) On February 22<sup>nd</sup> 2013, Israeli forced detained Jihad Da'doush in Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Sami Abu Samara in Yatta.

#### • Demonstration:

- (i) At 18:00, a demonstration took place in Sa'ir in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and against the killing of Arafat Jaradat who died under Israeli interrogation in Majdo prison.
- (ii) At 22:55, a demonstration took place in Beit Anun in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and against the killing of Arafat Jaradat who died under Israeli interrogation in Majdo prison.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town for Sabbath holiday.

# ALL DISTRICTS

- At 21:00 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and injured 3 residents.

# NORTHERN GAZA

- Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards several residents located near the border fence in Jabaliya and injured

# Detainees Update

 On February 23<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Arafat Jaradat (a Palestinian detainee detained rom his home on February 19<sup>th</sup> 2013 and resident of Hebron) died while in custody of Israeli prison officials. The Palestinian Authority Minister of Detainees blamed the Israeli Government and Israeli Prison officials for Jaradats death and called for an International Investigation regarding the circumstances of his death
