JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on February 23rd 2015, Israeli forces raided Qutna village, stormed a home and detained a resident. (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, occupied several homes and converted their rooftops into military posts, clashed with several residents as they searched 10 homes, detained 3 residents and temporarily detained Yazen Al-Khatib then released him later. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On February 22nd 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud area in Jerusalem detained Rami Al-Alami {An attorney for the Palestinian Ministry of detainees} and confiscated money from his vehicle for allegedly attempting to smuggle money to Palestinian detainees in Israeli Prisons. (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aqsa mosque compound detained Sana Shiekhat (A resident of Ras Khamis in Jerusalem). (iii) On February 23rd 2015, Israeli forces detained three residents including a woman: Tariq Al-Disi, Osama Abu Khater and his wife near Salah Al-Din road in the old city of Jerusalem. (iv) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Shamasneh in Qutna village. (v) Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohammad Abu Shalbak, Ahmad

	<p>Khader and Mohammad Abu Latifa in Qalandiya camp.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Expulsion:</u> On February 23rd 2015, Israeli forces expelled Shaymah Sharikh (15 years old) {A school girl} {Resident of Al-Eisawiya village} from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound. • <u>Attack,</u> At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tur neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces stormed “Dar Mall” shopping center on Salah Al-Din road in the old city of Jerusalem and confiscated a computer and closed down the fourth floor of the shopping center. (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces stormed a home in Beit Hanina and confiscated a vehicle and several files owned by Sa’ed Siyam • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atarah bridge located in North Bir Ziet until 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 13:30. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned at Atarah bridge located in North Bir Zeit fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 00:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Silat Al-Thaher. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Zubaba village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 02:40. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those

	holding special permits to enter through it.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Lid until 21:10. • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:50, Israeli forces raided Nazlat Issa village, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home then withdrew at 16:00.

(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints at the entrance of Azzun and along a road leading to Izbit Al-Tabib. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Al-Fandug and Hajja villages. (iii) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction, detained a resident then withdrew at 17:15. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on February 23rd 2015, Israeli forces raided Habalah and detained a resident. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Hajja village and set up a checkpoint. (iii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Jayyus, summoned 2 residents: Iz-Al-Din Khaled and Musa Bayda to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces positioned at Jit village junction detained Sharhabeel Al-Shuki (A resident of Qalqiliya). (ii) Israeli forces detained Rani Al-Sha’er in Habalah. • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near Asalah village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for allegedly attempting to climb the gate wall into Israel for work. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the

NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: At 12:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Nablus and Assira Al-Shimaliya until 16:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Bithan village until 10:00. SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) Since January 21st 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Deir Istiya with dirt mounds. • Checkpoints: At 17:40, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: At 19:00, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District until 21:10. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village. (ii) At 23:45, Israeli forces raided Jericho until 01:45.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area

in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At dawn on February 23rd 2015, Israeli forces raided Za'tara and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and as a result killed a residents and summoned Saleh Al-Ja'idi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:35.

- **Killing:** Israeli forces killed Jihad Al-Ja'fari in Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Mohammad Thouwib in Za'tara.
- **Temporary Detention:** At 12:15, Israeli forces temporarily detained several school students in Taqou' then released them later.
- **Attack:** At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Iskan area in Beit Jallah opened fire towards a vehicle, which managed to flee the area.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge, temporarily seized a Palestinian Police vehicle then allowed to pass through at 12:10.
 - (ii) At 12:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sa'ir until 12:50.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 18:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp until 19:05.
 - (ii) At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Halhul, opened fire as they stormed and searched several homes and summoned Ali Al-Zama'rah to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:00.
- **Land Levelling:** At 18:00, Israeli forces stormed Khirbeit Zunah area located in south Al-Thahiriya near "Sham'iyah" settlement and levelled a plot of land owned by Al-Tal family.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza, Central Gaza and Khan Yunis. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Central Gaza and as a result injured a resident in North Gaza.

(iii) On the morning of February 24th 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of West Beit Lahiya and as damaged a fishing boat

(iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
