#### **WEST BANK**

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Raid: At 17:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya, clashed with several residents and detained a child.

## • Detention:

- (i) On February 23<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Suliman (A resident of Al-Judayrah village) as he was returning from Al-Quds University in Abu Dis.
- (ii) At 04:40 on February 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Zir and damaged home furniture as they stormed Ahmad Al-Zirs home and assaulted several of his family members in Qalandiya camp.
- (iii) At 11:00, Israeli forces detained four residents: Jihad Al-Ghazawi, Fatimah Aliyan, Lutfiya Mughimer and Khadijah Ghawayis as they were exiting Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (iv) On February 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained three children: Imad Ghanam (16 years old), Majdi Al-Hadarah (17 years old) and Riyad Sinuqrout (17 years old) in Al-Tur neighbourhood.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Badr (15 years old) in Al-Eisawiya village.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> On February 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem temporarily detained three children: Abedel-Nasser Abu Snieneh (13 years old), Mustafa Abu Snieneh (13 years old) and Omar Ghunayem (13 years old) then released them after an Israeli court sentenced them to 5 days house arrest
- Expulsion: On February 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces expelled Wasil Idris and Sana' Shayakha from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 45 days.
- Attack: At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Qaddum area in Silwan neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

### • Settler Violence:

- (i) At 16:50, a group of Israeli settlers from "Bat Ein" settlement located in east Jub'a village temporarily abducted Nu'man Hamdan (A resident of Al-Jub'a village) as he was working in his farm land near the settlement then they released him at 17:05.
- (ii) At 00:10, a group of Israeli settlers from "Betar Aliyat" settlement opened fire towards homes in Nihalin village.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

## • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 10:25, Israeli forces set up four checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar, Wadi Qabbun area, Beit Einun and Fawar junctions.
- (ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Bani Na'im.

#### Raid:

- (i) At 06:50 on February 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Adisiya village demolished a concrete fence owned by Nasser Jarradat for allegedly being built without a licence.
- (ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces raided Khirbeit Ghiyoun village located in the south area of Al-Samou', served military orders for the demolition of several tents for allegedly being built without licence.
- (iii)At dawn on February 25<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed and searched several homes and detained a resident.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Rab'I Awad in Beit Ummar.

#### • Attack:

- (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Shuhada' road in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who were protesting against the closure of the road and demanding the road to be open to allow free movement for residents during which clashes erupted between demonstrators and Israeli forces.
- (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired stun and tear

gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 08:45, Israeli forces stormed Wadi Al-Baqr area located near the entrance of Bani Na'im and demolished a livestock (Cattle) barn owned by Imad Al-Rajabi.

ALL DISTRICTS	• At 19:00 on August 26 <sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
