JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Expulsion:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On January 23rd 2015, Israeli courts in Jerusalem released Mohammad Abu Al-Humus (A resident of Al-Eisawiya village) after posting 2000 NIS bail and imposed his expulsion from his home to Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem and placed under house arrest until February 26th 2015 as well as preventing him from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 60 days. (ii) On February 25th 2015, Israeli courts in Jerusalem released 4 residents: Khadija Abu Khawies (after posting 1500 NIS bail and preventing him from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 60 days), Jihad Ghazawi (after posting 1500 NIS bail and preventing him from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 20 days), Fatima Aliyan (after posting 1500 NIS bail and preventing him from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 20 days) and Latfia Mughier (preventing him from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 10 days). • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:30 on February 25th 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning and as a result injured three children. (ii) At 07:30 on February 25th 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Za’im village fired stun grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning. (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces in Ein Al-Louz area in Silwan neighbourhood in

	<p>Jerusalem fired stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces stormed Al-Eizariya and served military orders for the demolition of a barracks owned by Mohammad Al-Basha and Ahmad Abu Sa'aydeh for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. (ii) At dawn on February 26th 2015, a group of Israeli settlers stormed south Jerusalem, set fire to a church and sprayed racist graffiti slandering Jesus on the outer walls as a result damaged the church. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge located in North Bir Ziet until 16:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Mazra'a Al-Sharqiya until 10:45. (ii) At 11:10, Israeli forces raided Ein Yabrud village until 11:35. (iii) At 22:25, Israeli forces raided Deir Jrier village and clashed with several residents.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamoun, stormed a steel mill, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the morning of February 25th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Zubaba village detained Ahmad Abu Ta'miya (A resident of Zubaba). (ii) Israeli forces detained Talal Abu Tul in Al-Yamoun. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:20, Israeli settlers stormed the area of "Homish" settlement (previously abandoned) then withdrew at 11:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Aqaba village. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Baradala village junction.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road

QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Muntar area near Azzun. (ii) At 09:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun and impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the entrance gate then reopened it at 10:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Jayyus. (ii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, detained a resident then withdrew at 07:00. (iii) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Azzun, detained a resident and temporarily detained Mohammad Radwan and released him at a later time then withdrew at 03:40. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Ali Nazzal in Qalqiliya. (ii) Israeli forces detained Sanan Radwan in Azzun. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 21:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Munatar area in Azzun assaulted the child Adel Omran (14 years old) as he was walking home. • <u>Installation of Military Post:</u> At 13:10, Israeli forces installed several tents near the entrances of Jayyus and Izbit Al Tabib village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 13:55, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint until 14:40. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Salim village until 12:00. (ii) At 12:50, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq junction until 14:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Azmut and Deir Al-Hatab, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning by Intelligence officers and then clashed with several school children in Salim village and withdrew at 13:30. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Ein Buis village until 15:30. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 03:25, Israeli settlers driving two vehicles stormed Nablus city and attempted to enter the area of Josephs Tomb then Palestinian Police officer guarding the area were able to force the settlers from the area.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) Since January 21st 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Deir Istiya with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja junction, temporarily detained two residents: Mohammad Dariyat and Eyad Irmeleh then released them at 19:00. (ii) At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 19:20.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from

accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Al-Shuwarat village until 18:40.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 09:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Jub'a village, surveyed surveillance footage near a mosque in order to investigate the burning of the mosque by Israeli settlers. As mentioned in the previous report
 - (ii) At 16:10, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village until 17:00.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned near Um AL-Rakaba area located in Al-Khadr fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident for alleged stoning

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nabi Yunis area.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Rayhiya village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 12:10.
 - (ii) At 17:15, and again at 01:35, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a home then withdrew at 04:10
- **Assault on Education Sector:**
 - (i) At 07:50 on February 25th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Al-Ibrahimiya school in the old city of Hebron and detained a child.
 - (ii) At 08:05, Israeli forces stormed Qarbata School in the old city of Hebron and surveyed surveillance tapes from the school.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Hussein Marar (14 years old) in Al-Ibrahimiya school in the old city of Hebron.
- **Attack:** At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Sahlat area in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained Karam Musouda.
- **Physical Assault:** At 13:25, Israeli forces positioned in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained and assaulted Ziyad Al-Shawrmeh for allegedly attesting to cross into Israel for work then released him at a alter time
- **Settler Violence:**
 - (i) At 09:40, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and stormed a home and Al-Sumoud center who were demonstrating against settlement construction.
 - (ii) At 11:45, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron and Abdel-Rauf Al-Muhtasib then Israely forces temporally detained him then released him at a later time.
 - (iii) On February 25th 2015, a group of Israeli settlers uprooted 100 Olive trees which were planted by International and Local peace activist.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza.

<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

(ii) On the evening of February 25th 2015, Israeli forces detained the child Abdallah Al-Haddad (16 years old) {Resident of Al-Maghazi camp) as he was attempting to climb the border fence into Israel.
