## WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	Closure:  (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.  (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.  Closure of Main Roads:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.  Checkpoints:  (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.

(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

#### Attack

- (i) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near "Kojav Yacoub" settlement in Kafr Aqab fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ahmad Odwan and Maher Naji.
- (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned between Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud area in the old city of Jerusalem fired tear gas grenades towards residents as they were participating in Jihad Al-Tawils {A Palestinian detainee who died while in Israeli custody} funeral for alleged stoning
- <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces stormed Shufat neighbourhood in Jerusalem and forced Lu'ay Al-Sha'er to demolish his own home as well as impose a financial penalty for allegedly being built without a licence.
- <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and temporarily detained several worshipers inside the mosque.

#### • Detention:

- (i) On the morning of February 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained Abdullah Badran in Al-Salasleh neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (ii) On the morning of February 26<sup>th</sup>2 014, Israeli forces detained Tariq Al-Halouni and Mustafa Bibris in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- (iii) At 05:00, Israeli forces detained Wissam Hamoudeh after storming his home in the old city of Jerusalem.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Deir Nathim village and clashed with several resident.
- (ii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Saleh village, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and detained a resident.

- (iv) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Bir Ziet, installed several checkpoints, impeded the free flow of traffic as they stormed several homes {after announcing the area as a closed military zone}, temporarily detained several residents inside their home after assaulting them using police dogs during which Israeli forces opened fire as they searched the home then fired several missiles inside the home which caused a massive fire and

	caused a portion of the home to collapse during which Israeli bulldozers demolished the remaining section of the home and detained 2 residents and killed another as well as leaving several others suffocating from tear gas inhalation and disrupted school activity in the village as they prevented school children from leaving their homes to go to school.  • Assassination: Israeli forces assassinated Mu'taz Washaha after opening fire as they stormed his home in Bir Zeit.  • Detention:  (i) Israeli forces detained Fadil Al-Tamimi in Al-Nabi Saleh village.  (ii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Samer Hadib and Fadi Washaha in Bir Zeit.  • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

Flying Checkpoint: (i) At 08:00 and again at 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of immatin village. Raid: (i) At 22:15, Israeli forces raided Jinsafut village. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Funduq village **Detention:** At 02:20 on February 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained Yazen Ismail in Azzun. **Wall Gates:** (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement. Closure: Since December 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-(i) Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the (ii) southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. **Flying Checkpoint:** (i) At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Shave Shomron" settlement junction" and temporarily detained "Lu'ay Naji, a national security force officer then released him at 15:45. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at Burin village junction, detained 4 residents including 2 Security force officers: Amjad Eid and Mohammad Assus, Billal Eid and Munir Oaddus then released them at **NABLUS** 17:15. (iii) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up checkpoint at Sarah village junction. (iv) At 18:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qussin village junction until 20:20. Raid: (i) At 10:50, Israeli forces raided Beita village until 11:30. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli force raided Sabastiya village 14:15. (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus, stormed several merchant shops,

confiscated several surveillance tapes and again at 23:10, Israeli forces

- raided Nablus while escorting Israeli settlers who stormed Josephes tomb, clashed with several residents and as a result injured Issa Hashhash (16 years old) then withdrew at 04:55.
- (iv) At 16:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Labban Al-Sharqiya, served halt to construction orders for 7 buildings owned by: Omar Owied, Abdel Rahman Oweid, Ihsan Daraghmeh, Ahmad Oweid, Mohammad Darghmeh, Yusuf Darghmeh and Mohammad Azar.
- (v) At 20:15, Israeli forces raided Burin village, clashed with several residents, detained several residents then released them at a later time during which they detained a residents then withdrew at 22:05.
- (vi) At 20:45, Israeli forces raided Osdirin village ,clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and as a result injured Faraj Adli and temporarily detained 16 residents then released after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officer, detained a child then withdrew at 22:05

#### • Detention:

- (i) , Israeli forces detained Abdel Rahman Handiya in Nablus.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Najjar in Burin village.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Ayham Adeli (17 years old) in Osirin village.
- <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 08:20, Israeli forces stormed Aqraba village and served demolition orders for a livestock den owned by Firas Bani Fadel for allegedly being built without a licence.

#### • Settler Violence:

- (i) At 15:35, Israeli settlers stormed Burin village, stoned several residents and vehicles then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces.
- (ii) At 15:40, Israeli settlers stormed Huwara stoned several residents and vehicles.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
- (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.
- (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.
- <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Alcheckpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Iskaka Village Bridge until 14:40.
- (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Bruqin and Kafr Al-Dik until 17:30.

- (i) At 20:20, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home, temporarily detained 2 residents and detained another then withdrew at 22:45.

### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the entrance of Beit Sahur until 14:55.
- (ii) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance Beit Sahur until 20:40.
  - At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the western entrance of Beit Fajar.
- (iii)At 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan and detained a resident.
- <u>Raid:</u> At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Sahur, set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 15:25.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Sharif Abu Fanoun in Husan village

#### • Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1<sup>st</sup> 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21<sup>st</sup> 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

#### **HEBRON**

- (vi) Since December 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Yatta abd Al-Rayha village until 22:40

- (i) At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned near "Hajji" settlement in south Hebron temporarily detained Ahmad Salto ( A paralyzed resident), assaulted him then released him at 19:50.
- (ii) At 18:50, Israeli forces temporarily detained 3 residents including a child and a special needs patient: Mohammad Al-Zur (13 years old), Fayez Al-Zour (9 years old), Ahmad Al-Lasouti (a special needs patient) near Karyat Arba' settlement then released them at a later time.

#### • Attack:

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces positionedat the entrance of Al-Urub camp, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards school children for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 11:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Fuwar village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
