JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. Raids: The Israeli army raided the town of al-Izariyyeh, searched a number of civilian houses, and arrested 2 civilians. Arrests: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army arrested in the old city of Jerusalem civilian Hussam Ilayan. The Israeli army arrested in Ras al-'Amud neighborhood in the city of Jerusalem civilian Mufid Amin Atallah. The 2 civilians arrested in the town of al-Izariyyeh are: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Saleh Shokeh; and Mahmoud Fayez Bassah. House Demolition: The Israeli army handed 2 house demolition orders in the old city of Jerusalem to civilians Ahmad Abdel Raouf Gosheh and Abdel Rahman Abu Farjah. Demolition of Property: The Israeli army handed orders to demolish a blacksmith workshop in Silwan neighborhood in the city of Jerusalem belonging to civilian Jamil 'Amer al-Abbasi. Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu

	<p>Dis with cement blocks.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to ‘Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba’ road, the area of al-‘Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.

<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the western entrance to the village of Safa with cement blocks.</p> • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of ‘Atara and impede civilian access. • Flying Checkpoints: At 21:40, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the village of ‘Um Safa, and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raids: <p>(i) At 11:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Jifna and searched a number of civilian houses.</p> <p>(ii) At 01:40, the Israeli army raided the city of Ramallah and the town of Beitunia, occupied roofs of civilian houses and converted them into military posts and searched one building in the town of Beitunia, arrested 2 civilian brothers in the city of Ramallah, and withdrew at 03:20.</p> • Attacks: at 14:30, the Israeli army stationed at one of the watch towers set up near the apartheid wall south of the city of al-Bireh fired sound and tear gas bombs towards Palestinian children under the pretext of stone throwing. • Arrests: <p>(i) At 01:20 on February 27, the Israeli army arrested, during a raid into the town of Silwad, civilian Ziyad Mish’al, a village council member.</p> <p>(ii) The 2 civilians arrested in the city of Ramallah are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Ahmad Karam al-Looloo; and his brother (b) Imad. </p> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of ‘Abud as well as in the areas of al-Midya to Ni’lin and Ni’lin to Deir Qaddis.

	<p>to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads between the city of Tubas and the village of Al Jadida, the towns of Al Yamun and Birqin, the town of Aqaba and the village of Al Kufeir, and the villages of Ajja and the Ar Ramah.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the city of Jenin and the town of Qabatia, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 15:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the towns of al-Yamon and Silet al-Harithiyeh. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Silet al-Harithiyeh. The raid occurred at 03:15 during which the Israeli troops fired sound bombs and searched a number of civilian houses. In addition, the Israeli army arrested 10 civilians, including a child and a military officer. The Israeli army withdrew at 05:15. (ii) At 00:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Abu Da'if, searched as cultural center after detaining civilians who were in it in the open but released them later, and withdrew at 01:45. (iii) At 00:30, the Israeli army raided the village of al-Araqa, opened fire and fired sound bombs during patrol, and then withdrew at 05:15. (iv) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Jaba' and arrested 2 civilians. (v) At 03:30, the Israeli army raided the town of al-Yamon, searched a number of civilian houses, and withdrew at 05:00. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The 10 civilians arrested in the town of Silet al-Harithiyeh are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Ayham Bassem Jradat; (b) Military officer Mohammad Adnan Jradat; (c) Tal'at Husni Shawahneh; (d) Fadi Riyad Zayyoud; (e) Jihad Ahmad Abu Shqeir; (f) Mohammad Fouad Abu Shqeir; (g) Ahmad Imad Abu Shqeir; (h) Adham Bassem Jradat; (i) Sari Riyad Safouti; and (j) Fouad Sayel Samoudi. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Palestinian Attacks:</u> At 14:30, armed individuals opened fire towards the Israeli army near the junction of the town of Qabatia. At once the Israeli army combed the area. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
TOUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Toubas, set up a checkpoint at the western entrance to the city, and withdrew at 12:40. (ii) At 13:10, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Iqaba.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarm a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil's plain; the road to the town of Deir al-Ghusun's plain; and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khamis. (ii) The Israeli army closed with dirt barricades the entrance to the town of Bal'a (isolating it from the city of Tulkarm and the neighboring towns of villages). • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarm-Nablus road and at Jubara checkpoint and impede civilian access. At 08:00, the Israeli army denied access through the two checkpoints to civilians from Tulkarm who are less than 35-years-old. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 11:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the village of al-Jaroushiyyeh, and searched civilians and vehicles until 17:00. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Anabta and patrolled it until 11:40. (ii) At 10:50, the Israeli army raided the village of Zeita, and patrolled it until 11:40. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road

	<p>connecting the town of ‘Azzun to the village of ‘Asla.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint that is set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya and impede civilian access. At 14:15, the Israeli army closed the checkpoint under the pretext of exploding a suspicious object. The checkpoint was reopened at a later time. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance to the city of Qalqilya, and withdrew at 14:00. (ii) At 14:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the towns of Jayyous and ‘Azzun, and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> At 18:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Habla. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Land leveling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and ‘Azzun.
NABLUS	<p><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only. (ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan. (iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of ‘Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases. (iv) At 12:20, the Israeli army closed Beit Iba checkpoint and impeded traffic. In addition, the Israeli arrested 3 civilians, including 2 children under the pretext of finding explosives with them.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus, opened fire towards civilians, and killed one civilian and injured 3. In addition, the Israeli army arrested 4 injured civilians, including 2 injured civilians. The Israeli army withdrew at 12:00. (ii) At 03:20, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and the refugee camp of Balata, clashed with armed individuals during house search, killed 2 civilians (described as “wanted”), including one military officer, injured 2 civilians and arrested 2 civilians, including one injured civilian. The Israeli army withdrew at 06:40. • <u>Deaths:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The civilian killed in the city of Nablus is Ibrahim Zaki Issa al-Mseimi. (ii) The 2 civilians killed in the refugee camp of Balata are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Military officer Ahmad Adel al-Nadi; and (b) Maher Salim Abu al-Reesh. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The 3 civilians arrested at Beit Iba checkpoint are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) ali huassam al-‘Ajooz, 16; (b) Mohammad Nasser Boshkar, 16; (c) Iyad Ahmad Rohi al-Okkeh. (ii) The 4 civilians arrested in the city of Nablus are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Wa’el Zaki Issa al-Mseimi; (b) Yasser Ismail Salam; (c) Ibrahim Omar Jibril; and (d) Ali Musa’ed. (iii) The 2 civilians arrested in the refugee camp of Balata are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Injured civilian Mohammad Samih Abu Arab; and (b) Sanad Subhi Saleh Mansour.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the agricultural road connecting the village of Iskaka and the bypass road (trans-Samaria) near Ariel settlement. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za’tara checkpoints and to deny civilian access. • <u>Raids:</u> At 01:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Marda. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north

	of the settlement of Ariel.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah. • Flying Checkpoints: At 20:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of Vered Yeriho settlement at the south entrance to the city of Jericho, and searched civilians and vehicles.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road. (ii) The Israeli army closed the only entrance to the village of al-Dheeb with dirt barricades and cement blockades. • Flying Checkpoints: at 16:35, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the area of al-Nashash (southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem), and searched civilians and vehicles until 17:30. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Obaidiyyeh. (ii) At 19:40, the Israeli army raided the village of al-Zeer, besieged a mosque after afternoon prayer, and withdrew at 20:15. (iii) At 22:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Husan and arrested 4 civilians. • Arrests: The 4 civilians arrested in the village of Husan are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Khaled Ibrahim Hamamreh; (b) Jamal Hussein Hamamreh; (c) 'Atef Yassin Hammareh; and (d) Mu'taz Khaled Hamamreh.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khadr; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp. (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at al-Fawwar junction, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army set up 2 checkpoints at the entrances to the towns of Edna and Dura. (iii) At 07:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the passageway of the town of Halhoul and denied civilians access to the city of Hebron. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron, and set up a checkpoint.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 21:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Beit ‘Ummar. (iii) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Yatta and searched a number of civilian houses. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:30 on February 27, the Israeli army arrested 2 civilian brothers during a raid into the town of Beit ‘Ula. The arrested civilians are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Bahjat Fawzi Ibrahim al-Sarahin; and his brother (b) Mohammad. (ii) At 03:00 on February 27, the Israeli Army arrested during a raid into the town of Dura civilian Murshed Abdel Mahdi Tmeizi. • <u>Land Leveling:</u> at 16:30, the Israeli army razed 3 dunums of land planted with grapes and wheat near the town of Beit ‘Ummar. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:05, a bunch of settlers stoned Palestinian civilians in al-shuhada’ Street in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanoun (Erez) Crossing is partially open (to allow previously coordinated humanitarian access). • <u>Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:15, the Israeli army fired 1 missile from its post on the Green Line towards east of the town of Jabalia and killed 1 civilian and injured 2, including civilian Hammad Abu Murshed, who were seriously injured, and his wife who was slightly injured. (ii) At 16:30, the Israeli army fired a number of missiles from its post on the Green Line towards the area east of the town of Beit Lahia.
