DISTRICT	EVENTS

WEST BANK

The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up **ALL** on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the **DISTRICTS** northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank. Closure: At 11:00, the Israeli army closed the city of Jerusalem completely for a number of hours. The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. Additionally, the Israeli army combed the area alongside the apartheid Wall as a result of heated alarms of a suicide attack in the city. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to (i) Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-(ii) Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. **JERUSALEM** Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. Raids: At 14:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Biddo. **Wall Gates:** The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu (i) Dis with cement blocks. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna. RAMALLAH Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt

barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and impeded civilian access. At 18:20, the Israeli army closed the checkpoint completely and denied access until 18:50. **Flying Checkpoints:** At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the junction of (i) Halmish settlement, detained civilian Sharif al-Rabi and detained him at 12:00. (ii) At 24:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Surda, and searched civilians and vehicles. At 16:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Beitunia and patrolled it (i) until 16:30. At 22:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of al-Bireh. (ii) The Israeli army raided the village of Ein Yabroud and searched a (iii) number of houses. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of 'Abud as well as in the areas of al-Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. **Flying Checkpoints**: (i) At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the town of al-Yanoun, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 09:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Kafr Dan, and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 10:40, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Rumanna, and searched civilians and vehicles. **JENIN** (iv) At 07:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the town of Arraba, and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 23:00, the Israeli army raided the village of al-Shuhada' and opened (i) fire indiscriminately and fired sound bombs during patrol, resulting in the injury of one military officer from the National security Forces. At 00:25, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Jenin and its (ii) refugee camp. At 00:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Qabatia and clashed with (iii) armed individuals. At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Kafr Dan, opened fire (iv) indiscriminately during house search, and withdrew at 04:00.

	• Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted
	special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions
	of civilians living behind the Wall.
TOUBAS	 Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to close Tayaseer checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. Raids: At 21:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area located between the villages o al-Far'a and al-Badhan.
TULKAREM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil's plain; the road to the town of Deir al-Ghusun's plain; and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khamish. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem) as well as at 'Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city). At 14:50, the Israeli intelligence investigated a number of civilians at 'Einav checkpoint. Raids: (i) At 09:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Tulkarem. The raid recurred at 03:00 during which the Israeli army searched a number of houses. The Israeli army withdrew at 06:10. (ii) At 17:30, the Israeli army raided the area located between the villages of al-Nazla al-Shariqiyyeh and al-Wusta, and combed it. (iii) At 20:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Qafin, opened fired and fired illumination bombs, and withdrew at 21:20. (iv) At 01:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Lid and patrolled it until 05:30. Arrests: On December 30, the Israeli army stationed at Jabbara checkpoint arrested civilian Talal Shaaban Yacoub al-Hotari, Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
	 <u>Closure of Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun as well as the road that connects the town of 'Azzun to the village of 'Izbat at Tabib. <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint
QALQILYA	that is set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya and impede civilian access. • Wall Gates: (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.

	<u>Wall Construction</u> : Land leveling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun.		
NABLUS	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al-Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only. Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan. Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases. At 00:00, the Israeli army intensified restrictions at the checkpoints that are set up around the city of Nablus and impeded traffic. Raids: At 00:50, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and the refugee camp of Ein al-Ma', opened fire intensively, searched a number of houses, and withdrew at 04:40. 		
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western entrance to the town of Kafr al-Dik. The Israeli army continues to close the agricultural road connecting the village of Iskaka and the bypass road (trans-Samaria) near Ariel settlement. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za'tarah checkpoints and to deny civilian access. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ari'el. 		
JERICHO	Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent

	farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah. • Raids: (i) At 14:05, the Israeli army raided the village of al-Fasayel and handed several bedouins orders to evacuate their quarters in the village. (ii) At 21:10, the Israeli army raided the area of al-Nuoaymeh that is located to the north of the city of Jericho and combed it under the pretext of suspecting the existence of a suspicious object.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahour and Bethlehem. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. Checkpoints: At 16:15, the Israeli army intensified restrictions at the alcontainer checkpoint and impeded traffic. Raids: (i) At 17:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Teqoa and clashed with
	civilians during patrol, resulting in the injury of child Mohammad Izzat

	 (ii) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Khader. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the
	town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi
	Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the
	village of al-Walaja.
HEBRON	• Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at

- the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the passageway of the town of Halhoul and impeded traffic.
- (ii) At 21:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the towns of Surif and Kharas.

• Raids:

- (i) At 03:00 on December 31, the Israeli army raided the town of al-Rihiyyeh and clashed with civilians during search of 7 houses.
- (ii) At 10:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Surif and clashed with civilians during patrol. The raid recurred at 18:30.
- (iii) At 11:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron and searched Harbi Abu al-Dabat School. The raid recurred at 19:00.
- (iv) At 12:00, the Israeli army raided the village of al-Karma and demolished one house under the pretext of unlicensed construction.
- (v) At 23:35, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Yatta.
- (vi) At 00:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Sammou'.
- (vii) At 04:30, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp of al-'Arroub, searched one house, and arrested one child.
- (viii) The Israeli army raided the town of Edna, searched one hose, and handed one civilian a notification to report to the Israeli intelligence.
- <u>Arrests</u>: The civilian arrested in the refugee camp of al-'Arroub is Wisam Mohammad Abu Rayya.
- <u>House Demolition</u>: The house demolished in the village of al-Karma is owned by civilian Othman Youssef al-Awawdeh.

- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 09:40, a bunch of settlers from Hagai settlement that is located to the south of the city of Hebron, uprooted olive trees and razed orchard owned by civilian Kazem Mohammad al-Hallaq.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanoun (Erez) Crossing is partially open (to allow previously coordinated humanitarian access). Raids: At 22:00, backed up by combat helicopters, the Israeli army raided Palestinian area of Abu Safieh and the town of Beit Hanoun, opened fire intensively towards civilians houses, closed Salaheddin street, and clashed with armed individuals. In addition, the Israeli army razed large areas of agricultural land. Palestinian Attacks: At 12:00, two (unidentified) mortars were fired towards the Green Line. At 16:00, two (unidentified) mortars were fired towards the Green Line. On December 31, armed individuals fired 7 mortars towards the Israeli army on the Green Line east of the town of Beit Hanoun. At 19:00, one (unidentified) mortar was fired towards the Green Line. In the evening of December 31, two (unidentified) mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Al-Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is partially open to let in fuel. Air Patrols: At 13:20, F16 war planes flew over the city of Gaza and conducted mock maneuvers.
CENTRAL GAZA	 Raids: At 01:00, the Israeli army raided Palestinian areas east of the refugee camp of al-Breij. Palestinian attacks: (i) At 13:30, armed individuals fired 8 mortars towards the Israeli army on the Green Lone near Kisofim Gate northeast of the area of al-Qarara. (ii) In the evening of December 31, armed individuals fired 2 mortars towards the Israeli army on the Green line near Kisofim Gate northeast of the area of al-Qarara. (iii) In the evening of December 31, armed individuals detonated 2 explosives near Sarij Gate that is located on the Green Line to the east of the refugee camp of al-Breij, and at Kisofim Gate on the Green Line to the northeast of the

	town of al-Qarara.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (al-Awdah) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is partially open (from 08:35 to 12:30. The cargo of 28 lorries was allowed in). Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open (from 08:20 to 15:10. The cargo of 65 lorries was allowed in). Raids: In the evening of December 31, the Israeli army raided the area east of the city of Rafah and clashed with armed individuals.

Prisoners' Conditions

• On December 30, the Israeli military court at Opher detention camp sentenced prisoner Ibrahim Mohammad al-Halabiyyeh to life imprisonment. Ibrahim is a resident of the town of Abu Dis in East Jerusalem.
