The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. - (ii) At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Huwar area located near the north entrance of Halhul.
- (iii)At 19:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between the city of Hebron and the town of Beit Kahel.
- (iv)At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp.
- (v) At 19:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Urub camp
- (vi)At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhul bridge.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 11:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou’ , stormed several homes and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 14:00 and again at 20:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron, set up a checkpoint, clashed with residents as they stormed a home and detained a University student then withdrew at 01:30.
- (iii)At 15:15, Israeli forces raided Qabta village, clashed with several residents, detained 2 children and assaulted Abdallah Hantish (15 years old) and again at 21:00 Israeli forces raided Al-Qabta village, detained 12 residents including 3 children making the total detained to 14 residents and temporarily detained Ahmad Abu Hawash, Mohammad Hamdan, Moath Mohammad, Ali Mohammad, Mohammad Abu Hawash and Muntasir Abu Hawash then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers.
- (iv)On the evening of January 1<sup>st</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp and clashed with residents as they stormed several homes.

- **Detention:**

- (i) Israeli forces detained Nadi Hawamda in Al-Samou’.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained 14 residents: Mahmoud Haribat (14 years old), Qusay Al-Atrash (14 years old), Moath Ismail, Mohammad Ismail (14 years old), Yusef Mutier (16 years old), Ghalib Abu Atwan (17 years old), Ahmad Abu Za’nuneh, Mohammad Al-Atash, Mus’ab Abu Atwan, Mohammad Abu Ras, Amr Al-Atrash, Riyadh Abu Ras, Ma’moun Abu Atwan, Mohammad Harbiyat, Yunis Mahmoud and Mohammad Mahmoud in Al-Tabaqa village.
- (iii)Israeli forces detained Munir Dafush in Hebron.

- **Attack:** On the evening of January 1<sup>st</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
