JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:15 on January 1st 2015, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, clashed with several residents and as a result injured Mohammad Hamad and detained 2 residents including a Security Force officer. (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, clashed with several residents, detained 3 residents including a child and again at dawn on January 2nd 2015, Israeli forces raided the village and detained another 2 residents {total detained 5 residents}. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On January 1st 2015, Israeli forces detained Mu’tasim Abu Al-Hawa as they stormed his home in Altur neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (ii) At dawn on January 2nd 2015, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Saleh in Silwan neighbourhood. (iii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Sha’ban and Zahran Mohammad Zahran in Qalandiya camp. (iv) Israeli forces detained 5 residents: Mohammad Mustafa (17 years old), Fadi Atiyeh, Mohammad Abu Al-Humus, Mahmoud Aliyan and Munir Mahmoud in Al-Eisawiya village. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Absat gate (One of the main entrances leading to Al-Aqsa Mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem temporarily detained 3 residents: Malak Atwan, Ikhlas Raghed and Marwa Hamada. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned near Bi’r Ayoub area in Silwan neighborhood fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they stormed the area.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) Since 11:30 on October 27th 2014, Israeli forces blocked the main road near Al-Jalazoun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atarah bridge located in North Bir Zeit. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village, temporarily detained Manal Eid Al-Tamimi, Billal Al-Tamimi, Marwan Al-Tamimi and Osama Al-Tamimi then released them after being assaulted. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on January 1st 2015, Israeli forces raided Deir Ammar village and detained 2 residents after storming their homes. (ii) At 05:00 on January 1st 2015, Israeli forces raided Ni’lin, detained 3 residents including a child after storming their homes. (iii) At 23:05, Israeli forces raided Ramallah; clashed with several residents as they stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 01:39. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Yusef Odeh and Nassar Odeh in Deir Ammar village. (ii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mustafa Khawajah (17 years old), Mohammad Nafa’ and Mohammad Khawajah in N’lin. (iii) Israeli forces detained Musa Al-Ajlouni in Ramallah. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Ofar military base and prison fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Deir Nathim fired live ammunition towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On January 1st 2015, Israeli settler uprooted approximately 5000 Olive trees which were planted recently by several residents on agricultural land owned by Mahmoud Hamza, Rabah Hadbah, Jum’a Hamza, Tawfiq Hamza, Mufid Hijaz, Najih Hamza and Abdel-Qadder Hijaz located near “Adi Ad” settlement located in Turmus’aya.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad.

(ii) At dawn on January 2nd 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Jamalah village and detained a resident as they stormed a home. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Abu Issa in Al-Jamalah village.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:55, Israeli forces raided Khirbeit Barza village, levelled 20 dunumes (acres) of agricultural land and as a result uprooted several Olive trees and demolished a barbed wire fence owned by Salem Abu Al-Tib then withdrew at 11:55. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Um Al-Jamal area located in the North Jordan valley area and demolished 5 livestock dens owned by Ali Ka'abneh, Mohammad Ka'abneh, Saleem Kan'an, Fatimah Nassar and Khadr Al-Asmar then withdrew at 11:00. (iii) At 11:10, Israeli forces raided Khirbeit Attouf village, clashed with several residents as they stormed "Ziyad Abu Ein Garden memorial" and uprooted several Olive trees as they levelled the garden. (iv) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Bardalah village, detonated a UXO then withdrew at 16:10. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at Tayassir checkpoint temporarily detained Ismail Al-Fuqaha (A resident of Ein Al-Bayda village) then released him at a later time.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Lid junction until 12:35.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed a agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Azzun Bridge which connects Qalqiliya and Tulkarem and detained Hani Hatem Abu Haneh then withdrew at 11:30. (ii) At 17:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road connecting Jayyus and Azzun. (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 02:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed and searched 2 homes then withdrew at 12:30.

(ii) At 16:15, Israeli forces positioned at the east area of Azzun fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained 2 residents: Khaled Sudin and Ishaq Sudin then released them at a later time. • <u>Detention:</u> At 20:20 on the 41st of December, 2014, Israeli forces detained Saher Faraj , and Sadik Yassin during confrontations south east the city of Qalqewlyeh. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Azzun temporarily detained Mohammad Saleem then released at a later time. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Burin village junction and opened fire then withdrew at 18:55. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:10, Israeli forces positioned near Huwara checkpoint in south Nablus fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israel forces positioned at Huwarah checkpoint in South Nablus detained Thaer Hundiya. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 16:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Jalloud village located near “Eiyash Qddush” settlement outpost and inserted several bolts in the ground during which Israeli forces prevented local residents ploughing their land.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.

<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samou' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
