<ul> <li><u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.</li> <li><u>Attack:</u> On the morning of January 2<sup>nd</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards Al-Shuhada' cemetery in Jabaliya and as a result injured 2 residents including 1 resident who later died of his injuries: Adnan Abu Khater (who later died of his injuries) and Mohamad Wash'h.</li> <li><u>Air Assault:</u> At dawn on January 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014, Israeli fighter jets launched a missile towards agricultural land in Beit Hanun.</li> <li><u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces killed Adnan Abu Khater in Jabaliya.</li> <li><u>Detention:</u> On the afternoon of January 2<sup>nd</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained an unidentified individual as he attempted to climb the border fence into Israel from Beit Lahiya.</li> <li><u>Palestinian Attack:</u> On the evening of January 2<sup>nd</sup> 2014, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.</li> </ul>
