## WEST BANK

## JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
  - (i) On January 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014 Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikse villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikse village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
  - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic.
  - (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Detention:** At 20:40, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem detained Dima Al-Qanbar for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (iii) On the evening of January 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Demonstration:** At 15:40, a demonstration took place in Al-Sheikh Jarah neighbourhood in Jerusalem protesting against Israeli home evictions for the purpose of Israeli settlers.
- **Wall Gates:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem

The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.</li> <li>• On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.</li> <li>• Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire and launching tear gas grenades from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis and as a result injured a resident in North Gaza.</li> <li>• Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Rafah.</li> </ul>
