JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem and has set up checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound. • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to Dahiyat Bir Nabala northwest of the city of Jerusalem with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Qalandiya and Beit Iksa checkpoints, impeding civilian access. • Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, around the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim, and west of the village of Al Jib. • Raids/Obstruction of Elections: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Hizma and arrested 1 civilian. (ii) The Israeli army raided the village of Sur Bahir, raided 1 house where a candidate running for the upcoming Palestinian legislative elections was holding a meeting, and notified attendants that they are prohibited from holding elections-related gatherings. The Israeli army also threatened to summon Ahmed 'Atwan, a candidate running for the Palestinian legislative elections, to court if he holds meetings. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Nabeel Mahmoud Bani Nimreh in the village of Hizma. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Sheikh Tayseer at Tamimi, Palestine Chief Religious Judge, near Bab al 'Amud (Damascus Gate) in the old city of Jerusalem. • Settler Violence: A group of Israeli settlers erected barbed wire around 1 house, belonging to a female civilian, in the neighbourhood of Al Musrara in the city of Jerusalem.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil with dirt barricades. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of 'Abud. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:50, and again at 02:20, the Israeli army raided the city of El Bireh, searched 1 house, arrested 1 civilian, and patrolled the area.

	<p>(ii) At 01:20, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the village of Abu Shukheidim.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: (i) The Israeli army arrested Fadi Mousa Qar'an in the city of El Bireh. On 04 January 2006, the Israeli army arrested 5 civilians during its raid on Al Jalazun refugee camp, which was reported yesterday: (ii) Bajes Khalil Nakhleh; (iii) Jihad Mahmoud Ziyad; (iv) Mohammed Mahmoud Ziyad; (v) 'Uthman Kamel an Nakhleh; and (vi) Abdul Haleem Mohammed Ghannam.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades Al Jabriyat road, connecting the area south of the city of Jenin to Jenin refugee camp. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, impeding civilian access. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • Flying Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the towns of Tubas and Tammun, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access. • Raid/House Occupations/Detention: (i) Beginning at 01:20 on 03 January 2006, the Israeli army has remained positioned in the city of Jenin and Jenin refugee camp and continues to occupy a number of houses in the area surrounding Jenin refugee camp, which it has converted into military posts. Confrontations took place between civilians and the Israeli army while patrolling the area, during which the Israeli army injured 7 civilians, including 5 children. The Israeli army also arrested 2 children in the city of Jenin. The Israeli army remains positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning. (ii) The Israeli army raided the village of Zububa and searched a number of houses, after detaining residents. The Israeli army also took photographs of the house residents. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 children in the city of Jenin: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Tawfiq Mu'ayyad al Hajj Ahmed, 15 years old; and (ii) Mu'atasseem Hussam ar Rukh, 14 years old.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to impose a complete closure on the district of Tulkarem and to declare it a closed military zone following a suicide attack carried out on the junction to the village of Far'un. The Israeli army continues to impede civilian access to and from the district. • Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the town of Kafr al Labad and the village of Al Hafasa and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khmeish. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the towns of Bal'a and Deir al Ghusun with cement blocks.

	<p>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads connecting the town of Bal'a to the village of Al 'Attara, to the town of 'Illar, and to Dahiyat Iktaba in the city of Tulkarem.</p> <p>(iv) At 15:20, the Israeli army closed the detour road in the plain of the village of Ramin with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up near the settlement of 'Einav on the road connecting the districts of Tulkarem and Nablus and to deny access to civilian vehicles in both directions. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close Jubara checkpoint south of the city of Tulkarem and to deny civilian access in both directions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 08:00, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints on the junctions to the village of Al Jarushiya and the town of Bal'a, searched civilians and vehicles, and impeded civilian access in all directions. • <u>Raids/Detentions:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:55, an Israeli army patrol raided Dahiyat Irtah in the city of Tulkarem and patrolled the area. (ii) At 14:00, and again at 18:20, an Israeli army patrol raided the town of 'Anabta and detained a number of civilians, while it was patrolling the area. (iii) At 18:20, the Israeli army raided the town of 'Attil, set up a checkpoint in the town's centre, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area. (iv) At 20:55, the Israeli army, including 6 jeeps, raided the town of Bal'a, searched 1 house after detaining residents, and withdrew at 22:50. (v) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Tulkarem and Tulkarem refugee camp. (vi) At 07:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Deir al Ghusun and arrested 3 civilians, including 2 children. • <u>Arrests:</u> The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the town of Deir al Ghusun: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Mohammed Jawdat Qatu, 17 years old; (ii) Abdul Mun'em Tayseer Abdul Mun'em, 17 years old; and (iii) Nidhal Bassem 'Atiyyeh.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the village of Immatin and east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of 'Azzun and searched civilians and vehicles until 10:30.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 11:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Sanniriya and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raid: At 16:50, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the village of Kafr Qaddum.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main road leading to the district of Jenin between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. Instead, the Israeli army has forced civilians to travel along an unpaved 1.5-km-long road, which branches off from the Nablus-Tulkarem road and intersects with the Nablus-Jenin road opposite the village of Sabastiya. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of Beita with dirt barricades. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing Huwwara, Beit Iba, At Tur Mountain, and Beit Furik checkpoints around the city of Nablus. The Israeli army closes the checkpoints overnight and reopens them at various morning hours, with the exception of Huwwara checkpoint where civilians are allowed only entry into the city around the clock. (ii) At 19:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint and denied civilian access in both directions until 21:00. • <u>Raids/Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on 03 January 2006, the Israeli army raided the village of Beita and arrested 3 civilians. (ii) At 15:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Duma and arrested 1 child. (iii) At 17:30, an Israeli army patrol raided the village of 'Osarin and detained 1 child, claiming that he threw stones at Israeli vehicles. (iv) At 02:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Nablus until 04:30. • <u>Arrests:</u> The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the village of Beita: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Ramez Sa'id Hamayel; (ii) Lu'ay Ibrahim 'Adili; and (iii) Mohammed Kamel Dweikat. (iv) The Israeli army arrested Mohammed Labeeb Dawabshed, 15 years old, in the village of Duma. • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> At 00:40, armed Palestinian individuals opened fire towards Israeli troops positioned on At Tur Mountain. The Israeli troops responded by opening indiscriminate fire.

<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades. The road has been closed since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik with cement blocks. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the western entrance to the village of Bruqin with dirt barricades. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan with an iron gate and cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Deir Ballut checkpoint overnight and open it at various morning hours, impeding civilian access. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints at the southern entrances to the towns of Jamma'in and Az Zawiya and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:30, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the town of Kafr ad Dik until 22:40.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja is closed with cement blocks. The Israeli army prevents farmers not holding Jericho ID cards from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also sporadically impedes civilian movement into the city of Jericho, except for Jerusalem and Jericho ID holders. • <u>Checkpoints/Detentions:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint on the road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus and to impede civilian access. (ii) At 12:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at the checkpoint set up near the settlement of Yitav at the western entrance to the village of Al 'Auja and detained 2 individuals, including 1 Palestinian National Security officer. (iii) At 05:30, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at the DCO checkpoint set up at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho and detained a number of civilians. • <u>Flying Checkpoints/Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of 'Ein ad Duyuk, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access. (ii) At 10:20, and again at 15:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the junction to the settlement of Vered Yericho, detained 2 civilians, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access.

	<p>(iii) At 10:30, and again 17:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Al ‘Auja on the road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Arrest:</u> At 11:00, the Israeli army announced (through the DCO) that it had arrested Firas Hashem Jabr. (Jabr’s place of arrest is unknown). • <u>Attack on Property:</u> The Israeli army continues to implement a military order to close commercial shops on both sides of Road # 90 in the centre of the village of Al ‘Auja. The order is valid until 08 January 2006.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the road to the village of An Nu’mān in the north-eastern Bethlehem district, isolating the village. The Israeli army considers the civilians’ residence in the village illegal because they hold West Bank identity cards while their village is located within the Israeli-defined municipal boundaries of Jerusalem. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the villages of Husan and Nahhalin with cement blocks. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 16:55, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the “Container”) checkpoint, impeding civilian access. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues north of ‘Ayda refugee camp towards the area north of the city of Beit Jala and in the Everest area, northwest of the city of Beit Jala. • <u>Raids:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Al Khadr. At 01:55, the Israeli army raided the town again and fired flares, while it was patrolling the area. (ii) At 19:50, and again at 02:05, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Bethlehem until 02:20.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and barbed wire Ash Shuhada’ Street and the area of As Sahleh and with an iron gate the old gold market, all in the H2 section of the city of Hebron, denying access to civilians and vehicles. (ii) The Israeli army continues to implement a military order to close civilian commercial shops on both sides of the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba’ to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron from 06 November 2005 until 07 May 2006. Civilian vehicles are prohibited from travelling along the road unless they possess access permits. Only Israeli settler vehicles are allowed unrestricted access on the road. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with a dirt barricade the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino in the old city of Hebron, in addition to the iron gate that has been set up in the area.

	<p>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the area of Al Khan in the old city of Hebron with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Beginning on 16 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to close with dirt barricades the entrances to the village of Beit 'Einun, Al Fawwar refugee camp, the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul, and the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron. The Israeli army has also continued to close with dirt barricades Zif junction to the town of Yatta and the junction to the area of Farsh al Haw leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron. (ii) Beginning on 16 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to close the entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp with an iron gate. (iii) Beginning on 16 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to close the entrance to the town of Idhna with cement blocks. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues west of the town of Surif to Beit Ula, in the town of Idhna, from the village of Deir Samit to the village of Beit 'Awwa, from Beit 'Awwa to the village of Al Burj, and south of the towns of Adh Dhahiriya and As Samoa'. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:45, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the old city of Hebron and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 14:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Ar Ramadin and searched civilians and vehicles until 16:20. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Hebron and patrolled the area until 10:30. (ii) At 23:20, the Israeli army raided the area of Kanar, affiliated with the town of Dura, set up a checkpoint at its entrance, and prevented civilians from entering or exiting the area until 00:10. • <u>House Occupation:</u> The Israeli army continues to implement Military Order # T/02/05 to seize control of the roof of 1 house in the city of Hebron and to use it as a military point from 29 December 2005 until 11 February 2006. • <u>Palestinian Security Measure:</u> At 16:00, Palestinian security forces handed over 1 illegal hydraulic excavator, seized in the city of Hebron, to the Israeli authorities (through the DCO).

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Beginning on 16 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to impose a complete closure on the Gaza Strip, ostensibly due to Palestinian individuals' firing of mortars towards the Green Line. The Israeli army has prevented civilians and workers from crossing the Green Line.

**NORTHERN
GAZA**

- **Closure:** Beginning at 18:00 on 28 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to impose a buffer zone (through artillery and air attacks) in the area near the Green Line, including the areas of evacuated settlements, in the district of Northern Gaza. Prior to imposing the buffer zone, Israeli army combat aircrafts dropped fliers warning that civilians would put their lives in danger if they enter the designated area.
- **Closure of Crossing Point:** Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open to foreign nationals, VIPs, and humanitarian cases only.
- **Air Attacks/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:**
 - (i) At 23:20, an Israeli army F16 combat aircraft fired 1 missile towards Palestinian territory 200 metres away from 1 Palestinian National Security location in the area of the evacuated settlement of Dugit northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya.
 - (ii) At 23:30, an Israeli army F16 combat aircraft fired 1 missile towards the area of Abu Hasira north of the town of Beit Lahiya.
- **Attacks/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:**
 - (i) At 12:50, the Israeli army fired tear gas canisters from Point 38 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory near civilian houses northeast of the town of Beit Hanun.
 - (ii) At 14:25, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 23 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory north of the town of Beit Lahiya.
 - (iii) At 16:25, the Israeli army opened fired from Point 54 on the Green Line towards the area of Abu Safiyya east of the town of Beit Hanun.
 - (iv) At 18:00, the Israeli army fired 2 artillery shells from Point 64 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya towards the area of Abu Safiyya southeast of the town of Beit Hanun.
 - (v) At 00:45, the Israeli army fired flares from its location inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory north of the town of Beit Hanun.
 - (vi) Between 00:50 and 01:15, the Israeli army fired 2 artillery shells from Point 64 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya towards Palestinian territory in the area between 2 Palestinian National Security locations around the evacuated settlement of Eli Sinai northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya.
 - (vii) At 02:45, the Israeli army fired 1 artillery shell from Point 64 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya towards Palestinian territory northeast of the town of Beit Hanun.
 - (viii) Between 03:05 and 03:40, the Israeli army fired 5 artillery shells from Point 64 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya towards Palestinian territory east of the town of Beit Hanun.
 - (ix) At 04:05, the Israeli army fired 2 artillery shells from Point 64 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya towards Palestinian territory north of the town of Beit Hanun.
 - (x) At 07:15, the Israeli army fired 11 artillery shells from Point 64 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya towards Palestinian territory near 1 Palestinian National Security location in the area of the evacuated settlement of Eli Sinai northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya.

(ii) At 18:00, 3 unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.

CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> At 20:30, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.

RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah Crossing is partially open in both directions from 08:00 to 16:00 to passengers holding Palestinian IDs, humanitarian cases, and Arab and foreign diplomatic missions. • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> At 01:50, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards Karem Shalom gate on the Green Line. • <u>Palestinian Security Measure:</u> At 24:00, Palestinian security forces sealed off 3 holes made in the Egyptian border wall by armed Palestinian individuals during riots.
