The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras 'Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Lagef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-(i) Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Oabalan town; the (ii) southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. **Checkpoints:** (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00 (ii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. From 04:05 to 17:30. Israeli forces restricted access at Huwara (iii) checkpoint. Flying checkpoints: At 12:25, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of Yitzhar (i) settlement and searched civilians and vehicles. At 16:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction on Deir (ii) **NABLUS** Sharaf village and searched civilians and vehicles. At 18:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of Surra (iii) village and searched civilians and vehicles. At 19:05, the Israeil army set up a flying checkpoint on Nablus-Tulkarem (iv) Road and searched civilians and vehicles. 	(i) At 14:05, a group of settlers raided west of Bourin village, stoned civilian homes, and uprooted olive trees.
	(ii) At 15:00, a group of settlers assembled in Aseera Qabaliya village and clashed with civilians.
	• <u>Demonstrations</u> : At 16:55, a march set out towards confiscated land in Qra Bourin village during which civilians clashed with the Israeli resulting in several injuries.
	Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
	(ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.

	• Flying Checkpoints: At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the eastern entrance to Yassouf town and searched civilians and vehicles.
	• Raids: At 13:05, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Khirbet Qais village.
	• Settler Violence: At 15:00, a group of Israeli settlers raided and patrolled Al-
	Janayen area west of Yassouf town.
	• <u>Wall Construction</u> : Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
	• <u>Closure of Main Road</u> : The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks.

	(i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area.

	• Raids: At 23:55, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Marj Al-Ghazal village.

	(i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of
	the village.

#### (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi **BETHLEHEM** Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. **Flying Checkpoints:** At 11:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint the entrance of Jenata town and searched civilians and vehicles. At 15:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al-Nashash junction (ii) and searched civilians and vehicles... Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town. Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq (i) Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the (ii) Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as (iii) detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to (iv) the entrance to Al-Simiya village. Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances leading to Beit Ummar (v) town. Physical Assaults: The Israeli army positioned on Road 60 assaulted a civilian called Khalil Ali Mousa Hmeidat from the presidential guards and a resident of Bani Naim town causing him physical injuries that necessitated his transfer to Hebron hospital. **Flying Checkpoints:** (i) At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the entrance of Edna town and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 11:45, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the old city of Hebron and searched civilians and vehicles. At 12:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction on Abu (iii) Aska area in Al-Thahiriye town and searched civilians and vehicles. At 15:3, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in Ras Al-Jora in Hebron (iv) city and searched civilians and vehicles. (v) At 18:05, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of Nabi Younis

in Halhul city and searched civilians and vehicles.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 10:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Al-Sammou'
- (ii) At 11:00, the Israeli army raided Yatta town and arrested one civilian. The raid occurred again at 01:20 during which the Israeli army handed over to a civilian called Ahmad Mousa Mohammad Al-Najjar a summon to report to the Israeli military intelligence.
- (iii) A1 11:45 and at 00:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Bir Al-Nahjar and Ras Al-Jora areas in Hebron city.
- (iv) At 13:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Duma area near Al-Thahiriye town.
- (v) At 17:10, the Israeli army raided Sa'ir town and clashed with civilians.
- (vi) At 02:00, the Israeli forces raided Beit 'Ummar town stormed several civilian homes and arrested 2 civilians.

- (ii) The 2 arrestees in Beit 'Ummar are Yousef Mohammad Salem and Raed Sabarneh.
- (iii) At 15:18, the Israeli army arrested a child called Faraj Mohammad Al-Karaki, 18, near Al-Ibrahimi Mosque.
- (iv) The Israeli army arrested a civilian called Ahmad Ismail Abed Raboo on Ziv junction near Yatta town.

#### • Settler Violence:

- (i) At 14:15, a group of Israeli settlers stoned civilians in the city of Hebron.
- (ii) At 21:20, a group of settlers assembled on the northern entrance of Halhul town and withdrew at a later time.
- (vii) <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark.
