JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since January 6th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) Israeli forces continue to close the entrance to the Shofat refugee camp with cement blocks, which will impede the free flow of traffic in Ras Khamis, Ras Shihadeh and Salam neighbourhood in Anata and Shofat refugee camp in Jerusalem. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:30, the Israeli forces raided Al Eizariya, stormed a home, served Mahmoud Jabir, a Police officer, a summon to report to Israeli Intelligence Agency and withdrew at 02:20. (ii) At 04:50, the Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, stormed several homes and detained 3 residents. • Detention: The Israeli forces detained Ahmad Od, Ismail Od and Ali Mohammad. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu

	<p>Dis town.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, the israeli forces raided Al Mughayyir village and opened random fire. (ii) At 20:25, the israeli forces raided Beit Ur Al Tahta. • Detentions: At 19:40, the Israeli forces positioned at Beituniya checkpoint detained Subhi Alami, a resident of Ramallah for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20 and again at 07:30 on January 10th 2012, the israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Ya'bad village junction. (ii) At 07:30, the israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Zubaba. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, the israeli forces raided Araba. (ii) At 10:00, the israeli forces raided Meithalun and Saris village, served 3 residents, Hazem Rabay'a, Islam Abu Ali and Adnan Samara summons to report to Israeli Intelligence agency and withdrew at 11:30. (iii) At 17:00, the israeli forces raided Zubaba, clashed with residents and withdrew at 17:30. (iv) At 18:00, the israeli forces raided Ya'bad, clashed with residents and withdrew at 20:00. • Detentions: As mentioned in the previous report, at 03:30, on January 9th 2012, the israeli forces detained Mustafa Saba'na. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p>TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:50, the israeli forces raided Tayasir village. (ii) At 03:30, the israeli forces raided Bardala and Ein Al Bayda.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Settlers Violence: On January 9th 2012, an Israeli settler levelled land in Khilat Hamad located in Al Aghwar Al Shamaliya.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) At 13:00, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoints: Israeli army continued there restrictions on Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, the israeli forces raided Jarushiya, stormed a home and withdrew at 11:05. (ii) At 21:30, the israeli forces raided Beit Lid until 23:00. (iii) At 23:45, the israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 02:30. • Detentions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near a wall gate in Zeita, detained Mohammad Nu'man (15 years old) and Kamal Nu'man. (ii) At 17:35, Israeli forces positioned at Al Tayba checkpoint, detained and beat an unidentified mentally ill individual for allegedly attempting to assault an Israeli soldier. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians <u>granted</u> special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of Azzun (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00 and again at 18:15, the israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun village. (ii) At 17:05, the israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Kafr Laqif junction. (iii) At 18:15, the israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at near Jinsafut village. (iv) At 18:55, the israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Jit village junction. (v) At 19:30, the israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Hija junction. (vi) At 19:35, the israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Immatin village junction. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, the israeli forces raided Qalqilya and surveyed a plot of Agricultural land and withdrew at 11:00. (ii) At 11:05, the israeli forces raided Azzun, served Oday Hussein, Ahmad Haniya and Ala Rayan summons to report to Israeli intelligence agency. (iii) At 13:45, the israeli force raided Sir village. (iv) At 23:45, the israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Settlers Violence:</u> At 13:15, 3 Israeli settlers opened fire towards several children near Azzun for alleged stoning, during which Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00 (ii) At 05:00 Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. • <u>Flying checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:15, the israeli forces setup a checkpoint at Beita junction. (ii) At 11:00, the israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Salim village junction. (iii) At 14:45, the israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint Deir Sharaf junction (iv) At 14:55, the israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Tel village. (v) At 14:55, the israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Aqraba and Surin village. (vi) At 14:55, the israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Qusin village junction. (vii) At 15:00, the israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al Masalekh area junction located in eastern Nablus. SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years,

	<p>and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: At 14:50, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoints: At 16:45, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near the entrance of Deir Istiya and prevented access for an alleged suspicious object. • Raids: At 00:30, the Israeli forces raided Kafil Hares and Hares village until 02:30. • Detentions: In addition to those mentioned in the previous report, at 03:50, on January 9th 2012, Israeli forces detained 2 children, Ayoub Kleb(17 years old) and Ala Sultan (17 years old). • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: • Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area and at 19:25, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 20:15. • Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:35, 14:45, 21:30 and again at 01:20, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho city (ii) At 14:30, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Ein Dweik and restricted the free flow of traffic until 15:30. • Raids: At 09:45, the Israeli forces raided Jericho city until 11:45. • Detentions: On January 5th 2012, Israeli forces detained Salama Rashidat, Salama Yunis Rashidat and Hassan Rashdat in Jericho city.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. • Flying Checkpoint: At 07:15, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Dar Salah in Beit Sahur.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> At 02:35, the Israeli forces raided Za'tara until 03:20. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.
Hebron	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village. (v) Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances lead to Beit Ummar town. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:25, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Beit Ula and Tarqumiya. (ii) At 10:40, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Hebron . (iii) At 17:40, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of Hebron . • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On January 8th 2012, the Israeli forces raided Khirbet Um Al Kheir, served 7 demolition orders to Suleiman Al Hathlin, Yasser Al Hathlin, Salem Al Hathlin, Shu'ayb Al Hathlin, Mohammad Hathlin, Salam Hathlin and Mohammad Hathlin . (ii) At dawn on January 9th 2012, the Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained 2 residents. (iii) At 08:00, the Israeli forces raided Al Thahiriya until 08:15. (iv) At 09:50, the Israeli forces raided Al Sam'o until 10:00. (v) At 11:55 and again at 21:05, the Israeli forces raided Hebron. • <u>Detentions:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:50, the Israeli forces detained Ala Zeitun (15 years old) in Hebron city. (ii) Israeli forces detained Yusef Alamy and Ra'ed Sabarna during their raid into Beit Ummar. • <u>House Demolition :</u> At 19:45, the Israeli forces served 6 home demolition orders to Suleiman Santiya, Mohammad Santiya, Ghassan Burqan, Khaled Al

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire by opening fire and firing artillery shells from positions at the Green Line towards North Gaza, Gaza and Rafah. • Israeli Naval Vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishermen. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 3 projectiles towards the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. • Raids: On the morning of January 10th 2012, the Israeli forces escorting bulldozers raided Jabalia, entered 300 meters, opened fire as they levelled a plot of agricultural land.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Raids: On the morning of January 10th 2012, the Israeli forces escorting Bulldozers raided Al Tufah neighbourhood in Gaza city and opened fire as they levelled a plot of land.

(ii) On the morning of January 10th 2012, Israeli forces escorting bulldozers raided Sufa crossing and opened fire as they levelled a plot of land. • Attacks: At dawn , on January 9th 2012, the Israeli forces opened fire towards
