JERUSALEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints set up at entrances to the city of Jerusalem and Al Aqsa Mosque. (ii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued military order #S/02/09 closing the seam line area, an extension of the Wall. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill located in an area between the villages of Biddu and Beit Iksa. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al Bareed in Jerusalem city from the town of Ar Ram. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and only allows holders of Jerusalem IDs to access the city of Jerusalem. Flying Checkpoint: At 13:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area of Al Khan Al Ahmar (on the road connecting the districts of Jerusalem and Jericho) and searched civilians and vehicles. Attacks: At 14:00 and again at 21:00, the Israeli army in the periphery of Qalandiya checkpoint opened fire towards civilians who allegedly threw stones. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area of al-Yeizariya to al-Shayyah, from Beit Surik village to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of al-Jib village, in the vicinity of the village of Q
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the village of Sinjil, the village of Safa and the junction to the villages of Kafr Malik – Ein Samiya. Raids: At 15:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of El Bireh.

	 (ii) At 23:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Deir As-Sudan. (iii) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Ramallah, surrounded a building and searched an apartment inhabited by German students, arrested a foreign national called Eva who allegedly did not have a visa to enter the Palestinian territories. (iv) At 06:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Bir Zeit. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the town of 'Abud and in the areas of al-Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis.
JENIN	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to 'Arraba town, east of the settlement of Dotan. Flying Checkpoints: At 20:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Al Hafira and searched civilians and vehicles. At 23:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to the town of Arraba and searched civilians and vehicles. Raid: At 02:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Arraba. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
TOUBAS	 Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint, east of the city of Tubas, allowing civilian access from 06:00 to 22:00. Raids: At 20:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Bardala. At 02:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Tammun, searched a house and confiscated a computer and withdrew at 04:00. Arrest: On 10 January 2010, the Israeli army arrested the civilian Nidal Hasan Salameh Bani Odeh from the town of Tammun while working inside Israel.
TULKAREM	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the town of Kafr Al Labad and the village of Shofeh and the road between the villages of Shofeh and Izbat Shofeh. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarm-Nablus main road. Flying Checkpoint: At 21:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Beit Lid and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 06:30 on 10 January 2010, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Jarushiya and served summon to a civilian to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency. At 09:25, the Israeli army raided the neighborhood of Shuweika in the

	city of Tulkarm, searched a house and served summon to a civilian to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency. (iii) At 23:25, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarm, searched a number of houses and served summons to 4 civilians to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency. (iv) At 24:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Kafr Jamal and served summons to 4 civilians to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency. • Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILYA	 Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. Flving Checkpoints: At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance to the town of Azzun. At 11:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya, detained a civil police vehicle carrying 3 police officers, confiscated their IDs and demanded from them to report to Israel police at the settlement of Qadumim. The Israeli army gave them back their IDs after DCO intervention. They were served with notices and indictments to appear before a court and a financial guarantee of 2000 shekel (equivalent to \$500). At 19:05, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint in the area between the villages of Hajja and Al Funduq and searched civilians and vehicles. At 21:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Jinsafut. Raid: At 22:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Kafr Qaddum. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues south of the town of Jayyus as well as near the settlement of Alfeh Minesheh in the villages of Ras Tira, Magharet Ad Dab'a and Wadi Ar Rasha, located south of Qalqiliya city.
NABLUS	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the roads of Tel-Burin, Beit Furik-Salem, and the eastern entrance to the village of Al Lubban Ash Sharqiya; and with dirt barricades the southern entrance to the village of Duma, the eastern entrance to the village of Al Lubban Ash Sharqiya, the western entrances to the town of Aqraba and the village of Majdal Bani Fadil, the northern entrance to the town of Qabalan, as well as the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to Alon Moreh settlement. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close by an iron gate the western entrance to An Naqura village, opposite Shavi Shomron settlement.

Checkpoints: At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on (i) Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only from 07:00 until 02:00. Awarta commercial checkpoint is open for civilians from 05:00 until (ii) 20:00 and on Friday from 05:00 until 15:00. At 12:05, the Israeli army raided the town of Beita and arrested a civilian. (ii) At 23:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Qabalan. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested in the town of Beita the civilian Salameh Hammad. **Destruction of Property**: At 11:00, the Israeli army demolished in the village of Khirbet Tana, that is located east of Beit Furik town, 12 makeshift houses inhabited by 22 families, a school consisting of 3 classes and a number of folds for raising sheep. Palestinian Security Measure: At 12:20, the Explosives Engineering Unit of the Palestinian Police destroyed 7 artillery shells and an old hand grenade found during the digging of a water well in the village of Oarvut. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the northern entrance to the city of Salfit, and continues to close with cement blocks and iron gates the northern entrance to the town of Brugin and the western entrance to the town of Kafr Ad Dik. **Checkpoint:** The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impede civilian access. **Flying Checkpoints:** At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to (i) the town of Deir Istiva and searched civilians and vehicles. **SALFIT** At 15:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area (ii) between the town of Kifl Hares and the village of Hares. Again at 22:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles. Raid: At 00:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Az Zawiya. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Hares north of the settlement of Ariel. Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks. **Checkpoints: JERICHO** The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at al-Hamra (i) checkpoint and allow civilian access from 06:00 until 22:00. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions on the checkpoint (ii)

	 set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja and allow access only to civilians holding Jericho and Jordan Valley IDs and those possessing permits. Detentions: At 10:40, the Israeli army positioned at the junction leading to the village of Al Auja detained 4 civilians and released at 22:00 following DCO intervention.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. The Israeli army continues to prevent civilian access to an area that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads of Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmad and the sideway east of Beit Fajjar town. Flying Checkpoint: At 22:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on An Nashash area junction (the southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem) and searched civilians and vehicles. Raid: At 21:40, the Israeli army raided the village of Husan where confrontations took place with civilians while patrolling the area. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khadr and Beit Jala city; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of Ephrata settlement; and in the area surrounding al-Walaja village.
HEBRON	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the area located near the Green Line, south of Yatta town, evacuating the area of those inside it and denying them access to it. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa; the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron; the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp; the village of At Tuwani as well as the entrance to the town of Adh Dhahiriya. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from

- traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the villages of Al Karmil and At Tuwani and all roads leading to bypass Road # 60.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 14:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint between the towns of Tarqumiya and Idhna and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 14:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the settlement of Susiya and opened fire towards a civilian vehicle that allegedly did not stop at the checkpoint. As a result, the civilian driver Issa Turki Ash Shawahin sustained injury and evacuated to an Israeli hospital. The Israeli army arrested the brother of the civilian driver.
- (iii) At 16:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to the village of Beit Anon and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iv) At 22:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Al Fawwar junction and searched civilians and vehicles.

Raids:

- (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron. Again at 03:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area.
- (ii) At 10:25, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Ummar, detained 10 children who allegedly threw stones and released them at a later time following DCO intervention.
- (iii) At 13:45, the Israeli army raided Al Arrub refugee camp and arrested 2 children.
- (iv) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the towns of Sa'ir and Ash Shuyukh.
- (v) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Surif.


• Arrests:

- (i) The Israeli army arrested near the settlement of Susiya the civilian Mousa Turki Ash Shawahin.
- (ii) The Israeli army arrested in Al Arrub refugee camp Haytham Yousef Abu Ghazi, 14-year-old, and Salah At-Teeti, 14-year-old.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, in the periphery of Eshkolot settlement southwest of Adh Dhahiriya town and between southwest of Arab Ar Ramadin village and the village of Imneizil.

 At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the Israeli army declared a unilateral ceasefire. In the meantime, armed Palestinian groups declared a oneweek-long ceasefire. Meanwhile, the ceasefire was extended until



• Armed Palestinian groups breached the ceasefire by firing 4 mortars towards the Green Line.

NORTHERN GAZA	 <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open for previously coordinated humanitarian cases and foreign nationals. <u>Palestinian Attack</u>: In the evening of 10 January 2010, 4 mortars were fired towards the Green Line. 	
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is partially open for the transport of wheat and fodder. Al-Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. (On 04 January 2010, the Israeli army unilaterally announced closing the crossing permanently. The crossing was used for fuel transport.) 	
CENTRAL GAZA	 Air Attack: In the evening of 10 January 2010, Israeli UAVs fired a missile against armed Palestinian individuals east of Deir Al Balah city killing 3 armed Palestinians and seriously injuring 1 armed Palestinian. Killings: The Israeli army killed east of Deir Al Balah city: Awad Muhammad Abu Nusair; Hasan Ibrahin Al Qatrawi; and Huthayfah Al Hams. 	
KHAN YOUNIS	Activities not reported.	
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al Awdah) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transport of food and humanitarian assistance, and for the export of 3 trucks of strawberry and a truck of flowers.
