JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On January 3rd 2014 Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Biddu bridge. • <u>Raid:</u> On the morning of January 10th 2014, Israeli forces raided Anata and served a demolition order for a home owned by Ahmad Halaweh. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards sever residents during clashes in Anata. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several during confrontations in Al-Jib village and as a result injured Mohammad Shaba’neh (24 years old) after being struck with a rubber coated steel bullet in the head leaving him hospitalised. (iii) At 03:15, Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents during clashes in Abu Dis near the wall gate. • <u>Detention:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Abu Haniya in Anata. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On January 10th 2014, Israeli authorities approved tenders for the construction of 1400 settlement unites (600 units in “Ramat Slomo and 800

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) On the morning of January 10th 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Ur Al-Tahta and detained 3 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Nur Al-Din Suliman (13 years old), Mohammad Suliman (13 years old) and Jabr Suliman (13 years old) in Beit Ur Al-Tahta. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents: Sufiyan Al-Ramahi, Ahmad Qadah and Mahdi Thaher leaving them hospitalised. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near Beituniya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 15:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of settlement construction, demonstrators clashed with Israeli forces and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Bil'in village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with demonstrators and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Ni'lin village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with demonstrators, injured Ahmad Amireh and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis village.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces continue to increase their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Attack: On the morning of January 10th 2014, Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards several children as they were playing soccer near the wall gate in Kafr Sur. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoint: At 10:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 14:10, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, fired tear gas grenades towards a school, detained a child then at 03:00 stormed several homes, confiscated vehicle and detained 3 residents. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 4 residents including a child: Mohammad Barham (14 years old), Ibrahim Salim, Mohammad Salim and Ahmad Hussien in Qalqiliya. (ii) On January 10th 2014, Israeli forces detained Layth Odeh in Qalqiliya. • Demonstration: At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance, clashed with Israeli forces as they attempted to disrupt demonstrators, injured 3 residents: Mohammad Ammar, Mash’hour Jum’a and Mohammad Taha and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector impeded the free flow of traffic and closed gate the wall and as a result impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:52, Israeli forces raided Kafil Harris and stormed several homes then withdrew at 13:20. (ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 04:30, Israeli settlers stormed Kafil Harris and damaged 2 vehicles. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Neui'meh road (ii) At 12:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fasayil village • <u>Raid:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village, temporarily detained 2 residents: Bahjat Khadr and Oday Fadil as they apprehended their vehicle, detained a residents then confiscated an agricultural tractor. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Yusef Fadil in Fasayil village.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Since 14:00 on October 18th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Surif and Al-Jab'a village with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nashash until 10:10. (ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar and temporarily detained Omar Thawabteh (17 years old) {Special need child} and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ahmad Taqatqa (16 years old) in Beit Fajjar. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned at the west entrance of Taqou' fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 16:30, , Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Ayda camp fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result leaving several residents suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:40, , a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'asra village protesting against the construction of the wall and against the prevention of protestors from reaching the demonstration site during which Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards residents and as a result left several of them suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town due to severe weather conditions. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the

HEBRON

Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge
 - (ii) At 09:415, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar.
 - (iii) At 11:16, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.
 - (iv) At 15:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Huwara area in Halhul.
 - (v) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Farsh Al-Hawa area.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Ithna and stormed a home.
 - (ii) At 10:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Hawooz area and stormed several homes.
 - (iii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir and positioned in front of Palestinian Police headquarters and summoned Ahmad Jabarin to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- **Detention:** At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Aqab Al-Sa'di, a resident of Jenin.
- **Attack:** At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Sahalashla road in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Settler Violence:** At 12:40, Israeli settlers stormed Yatta and provoked several residents.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
