WEST BANK

Closure:

- The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem (i) city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata.

Raid:

- (i) At dawn on January 14th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Iksa village, stormed a home and summoned Suhayeb Hamayel to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (ii) At 18:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and detained a resident.
- (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Ijzah and clashed with its residents.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Ruomi in Al-Eizariya.

Attack:

- (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired live ammunition and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near Anata fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces and Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate (ii) on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-

	Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem		
	IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	 (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 18:50 on January 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the area between Al-Mughier village and a by pas road and the main road between Al-Mughier and Duma villages with dirt mounds. 		
	Flying Checkpoints: (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 18:00. (ii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Um Safa village until 18:00.

	• <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:15, Israeli settlers positioned at a by pass raod leading Salem village near "Alon Muriya" settlement assaulted several sheppards as they were herding their sheep in the area and an Israeli settler vehicle rammed 2 sheep then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces at 10:45.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and imped the free flow of traffic. Raid: At 11:50 and again at 02:50, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya, took photographs of several homes, stormed a home then withdrew at 04:00.
JERICHO	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at road (90) junction near Al-Nuwe'meh village located at the north entrance of Jericho until 11:20.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 3:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with

- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Kafar Itsiyon" settlement located along the main road connecting Bethlehem and Hebron and detained a resident.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint near "Kafar Itsiyon" settlement located along the main road connecting Bethlehem and Hebron detained Ahmad Akhlil (A resident of Beit Ummar).

Attack:

- (i) At 11:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 21:10, Israeli forces positioned near "Kafar Itsiyon" settlement junction opened fire towards a resident as he was near a settlker vehicle and as a result killed him.
- <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed Osama Abu Jandiya (A resident of Yatta in Hebron).

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

HEBRON

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Yatta until 10:25.
- (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints at the entrance of Yatta and Al-Fuwar junction until 19:40.
- Raid: At dawn on January 15th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed several homes, detained two residents and summoned the child: Ahmad Akhlil to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Khalid Akhlil and Mohammad Abu Daya in Beit Ummar.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Ummar fired Rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a resident injured Amal AlSalibi leaving her hospitalised with

contusions.

ALL DISTRICTS	• At 19:00 on August 26 th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
	 Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza and Khan Yunis.

NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	 Attack: On the morning of January 15th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several residents near agricultural land in Al- Maghazi camp.
KHAN YUNIS	• Attack: On the morning of January 13 th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several residents on agricultural land in east of Al-Qarrarah, Khaz'a and Al-Farahin area in Abbassan Al-Kabirah.
