JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

- Flying Checkpoint: At 14:30, Israeli forces set up several checkpoints along the road between Jaba' checkpoint (which connects Jericho and Ramallah) and Bab Al-Shams village located in the E1 area near Jabal Al-Tur.
- **Raid:** At 11:50, on the evening of January 15th 2013 and at dawn on January 16th 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village, clashed with its residents, demolished a protest tent, detained 6 residents including 4 children.
- Attack: At 15:00, Israeli forces stormed Bab Al-Shams village located in E1 area in East Jerusalem and temporarily detained 22 residents after interrogating them at Ofar prison.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Omar Abu Turk (14 years old), Basil Abu Sneineh (14 years old), Ibrahim Abu Snieneh (17 years old), Ehab Obied and Yaha Mustafa.

• Home Demolition:

- (i) At 07:30 on January 15th 2013, Israeli forces demolished a home (60m²⁾ owned by Nasir Al-Rajabi in Beit Hanina for allegedly being built without proper licencing.
- (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces demolished a home (120m²) owned by Arif Amira in Sur Bahar village for allegedly being built without proper licensing and clashed with residents who attempted to prevent the demolition.

Assault on Property:

- (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces issued an order preventing the rehabilitation of the African Diaspora Center in the Old city.
- (ii) On January 15th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the mandatory evacuation Raghdan Hotel of Al-Masara neighbourhood for unknown reasons.
- **Settler Violence:** On January 15th 2013, Israeli settlers stormed Silwan neighbourhood assaulted Yazan Theab (14 years old) and sprayed pepper spray in his face leaving him hospitalised with contusions and from gas inhalation.

Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sleavawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Yabrud village bridge.

Raid:

- (i) At 10:50, Israeli forces raided Abboud and clashed with its residents.
- (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Nathim, clashed with its residents and injured Yazan Al-Khatib (11 years old).
- Attack: At 10:40, Israeli forces positioned at the wall gate near Budrus village fired live ammunition and tear gas grenades towards several residents, killing a child and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- Killing: Israeli forces shot and killed Samir Awad (16 years old) in Budrus village.
- **Detention**: At 00:45 on January 15th 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh and detained Jamal Al-Tawil (Former Mayor of Al-Bireh city) as well as confiscating a computer from his home.

	 <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Isam Samoudi, Yazan Al-Halouh, Nubani Ighbariya, Foad Khadr and Salim Al-Hazouzi in Jenin. <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. Flving Checkpoint: At 09:20 and again at 15:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar until 17:15. Raid: At dawn on January 15th 2013, Israeli forces raided Bettar village, stormed a home and detained a resident.
