(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On January 15th 2014, Israeli forces detained Ehab Abu Jazzar in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) On January 15th 2014, Israeli forces detained 5 residents: Jihad Atwan, Munir Atwan, Ahmad Atwan, Ahmad Nimr, Dowiyat and Mohammad Doyiat in Sur Bahar village. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces served a demolition order for a vehicle garage for a home owned by Majdi Ja'abis in Jabal Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 11:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atara bridge. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Beitin village, occupied the rooftops of 2 homes and converted them into military posts then withdrew at 15:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:45 on January 16th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ur Al-Tahata detained Adham Daraj, a resident of Kharbathat Al-Misbah village. (ii) At 15:20, Israeli forces detained the child Abdel Ghaffar Hassan (16 years old) as he was travelling towards as Al-Halamish area and temporarily detained 2 other children after imposing a 1500 NIS approximately \$425 financial penalty to : Samer Badr (16 years old) and Mohammad Suliman (16 years old). • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:00, Israeli settlers stoned several residents and vehicles passing near "Nilli" settlement located in North Ni'lin. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis village.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed the area of "Homish" settlement (which was abandoned previously) then withdrew at a later time. (ii) At 16:00, an Israeli settler near "Haramish" settlement assaulted 2 children: Ahmad Nidal Abu Irmeleh (13 years old) and Ahmad Ghassan Abu Irmeleh (14 years old) with a steel pipe. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> On January 15th 2014, Israeli forces detained Mustafa Bisharat, a resident of Tamoun for allegedly carrying a hunting rifle as he was located near Al-Diwan area.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 16:15, Israeli forces continue to increase their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic, detained a resident and temporarily detained 7 residents then released them at a later time. • <u>Raid:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, Tulkarem camp and Ein Al-Shams camp until 12:55. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned at “Eniv” checkpoint detained Islam Al-Balbissi, a resident of Anabta. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Beit Amin and Izbit Suliman villages. (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Azzun and Kafr Thulth. (iii) At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction, detained a resident and temporarily detained Ziyad Al-Bata (A National Security officer) then released him at 19:30. (iv) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:15, Israeli forces raided Jayyus and stormed 3 homes. (ii) At 16:25, Israeli forces raided Azzun. (iii) At 18:25, Israeli forces raided Jit village stormed the village council headquarters and 2 homes, confiscated surveillance cameras owned by Fallah Yammin then withdrew at 20:15. (iv) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Habalat. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Hamad Badran in the area between Azzun and Kafr Thulth. (ii) Israeli forces positioned at Jit village junction detained Yusef Shihadeh, a resident of Nur Shams camp in Tulkarem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector impeded the free flow of traffic and closed gate the wall and as a result impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students

	<p>to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Tel and Sarah village until 14:10. (ii) At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Naqura village junction. (iii) At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction. (iv) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Osrin village until 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Sabastiya village. (ii) At 12:55, Israeli forces raided Sarah village. (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Aqraba, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 21:00. (iv) At 23:45, Israeli forces raided Nablus as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed Joseph's Tomb, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 03:30. • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 23:45 on January 1th 2014, Israeli forces raided Nablus and confiscated several surveillance cameras from a merchant shop.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 14:30, Israeli forces continue their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint until 18:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:25, Israeli forces raided Kafil Harris village as they escorted several Israeli settlers to a holy site then withdrew at 02:25. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:55, Israeli settlers positioned near Za'tara checkpoint stoned several residents and vehicles • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road 90 junctions near Al-Nu'emeh village. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Dima Tarza then released her at 23:30.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Since 14:00 on October 18th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Surif and Al-Jab'a village with dirt mounds • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, stormed a school and verbally warned the school administration that the school will be closed if stoning from the school continues towards Israeli settler vehicles then withdrew at 08:20. (ii) At 09:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Shuwarat village and set up a checkpoint. (iii) At 19:20, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem then withdrew at 21:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards the camp for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town due to severe weather conditions. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of

the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) On the evening of January 16th 2014, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge and detained a resident.
 - (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 13:20, Israeli forces raided Hebron and stormed a home.
 - (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa and set up a checkpoint.
- **Attack:** At 12:45 and again at 18:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Malik Al-Alami after a tear gas grenade struck him and Israeli forces detained 2 residents.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 14:00. Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Annan Al-Rajabi (16 years old), a resident of Hebron.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained Sufyan Jamjoum in Halhul.
 - (iii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Murshad Awad and Shihadeh Oday in Beit Ummar.
- **Confiscation of Property:** On January 16th 2014, Israeli forces served a confiscation order to confiscate a plot of land in the vicinity of Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron for military purposes.
- **Settler Violence:** At 12:15, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Jabal Jallas area in east Hebron and uprooted several Olive trees.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Gaza and Central Gaza. • Israeli Naval Vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Attack: At dawn on January 17th 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green line opened fire towards agricultural land located in Jaher Al-Dik located in east Gaza.
