#### **WEST BANK**

#### • Closure:

- (i) On January 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

#### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 13:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu.

#### • Attack:

- (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Alaa Nimr.
- (iii) At 17:10, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Kabsa junction in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained a child.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Ali Damdum (15 years old) near Abu Dis.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic

- (iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Since 14:00 on October 18<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Surif and Al-Jab'a village with dirt mounds

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 00:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Jallah.
- (ii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed a building and a home, summoned Malik Hassan to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:45.

#### • Attack:

- (i) At 11:55, Israeli forces positioned at the west entrance of Taqou' fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 14:30, , Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Ayda camp fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii)At 19:25, Israeli forces positioned near Nihilin village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Demonstration</u>: At 12:25, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'asra village
  protesting against the construction of the wall and against the prevention of
  protestors from reaching the demonstration site during which Israeli forces fired
  tear gas grenades towards residents and as a result left several of them suffocated
  from tear gas inhalation.

#### • Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town due to severe weather conditions.
- (ii)On May 1<sup>st</sup> 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21<sup>st</sup> 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

# (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.

### **HEBRON**

- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 10:05, Israeli forces raided Yatta and set up a checkpoint near the Palestinian National Security force headquarter.
- (ii) At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir, stormed a home then withdrew at 05:50.
- (iii)At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Halhul, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes and summoned 2 residents: Ma'moun Abu Zalta and Hakam Janazat to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:50.
- (iv)At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Sheyukh Al-Urub village and summoned Basel Halaykeh to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (v) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained a resident.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Farid Al-Jundi in Hebron.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 14:45, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Sahalashla road in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Khalil Farijat leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 09:45, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Um Al-Khier area in Yatta, attempted to plant several trees, assaulted several residents during which Israeli forces temporarily detained 2 children: Omar Al-Hithalin (13 years old) and Ahmad Al-Hithalin (14 years old) as they attempted to prevent the settler attack then released them at a later time.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

- At 21:00 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into
  effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an
  agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opened fire towards North Gaza.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Gaza and as a result injured 2 residents.
