JERUSALEM	 Closure: (i) Since January 6th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. Checkpoints: (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) Israeli forces continue to close the entrance to the Shofat refugee camp with cement blocks, which will impede the free flow of traffic in Ras Khamis, Ras Shihadeh and Salam neighbourhood in Anata and Shofat refugee camp in Jerusalem. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electron

	(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to
	search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the
	village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows
	residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at
	the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students
	to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of
	Karne Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement;
	and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
NABLUS	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-
	Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the
	settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the

- village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00
- (ii) Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. At 17:50 on 16 January, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint for some time, impeding the free flow of traffic.
- (iii) At 11:20, the Israeli army increased restrictions on Palestinian access at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (iv) At 13:35, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at "Shave Shamron" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

• Flying checkpoints:

- (i) At 11:15 and again at 03:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction until 04:20.
- (ii) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Beit Zun village.
- (iii) At 22:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Sarrah village junction.

• Raid:

- (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces raided Taka' area located in Aqraba and served notices to demolish 3 barracks owned by Wasfi Mohammad, GhalEb Mohamad and Mohamad Mohamad.
- (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Sarrah village until 16:20.
- (iii) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Odlah village until 16:45.
- (iv) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Burin village.
- (v) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Asira Al-Shimaliya.
- (vi) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Bathan village and searched a home.
- (vii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Askar camp in Nablus, clashed with residents and withdrew at 03:25.
- (viii) At 05:40, Israeli forces raided Azmut village until 06:00.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
- (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: At 11:00 the Israeli army increased its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 14:55.
- <u>Settlement Activity:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces installed a barbed wire fence along Abar Samara bypass road in Kafil Hares and Hares villages.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

	construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them
	access to the area.

Hebron

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
- (v) Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances lead to Beit Ummar town.
- (vi) Since 09:40 on January 10th 2012, the Israeli army has closed the entrance of Beit Amra village with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Ali Baqa mosque in Hebron.
- (ii) At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of Hebron.
- (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Awa and fired teargas grenades towards several minors for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Bani Na'im

• Raids:

- (i) At dawn on January 17th 2012, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, searched several homes while they rounded up and detained several residents in a nearby cave, fired sound grenades inside the home of Basem Al-Alamy and forced its residents out. Israeli forces also detained and assaulted 2 residents.
- (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 17:45.
- (iii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Yatta and detained 2 residents...
- Attack: At 15:45, Israeli forces fired rubber-coated steel bullets, teargas and stun grenades towards several children at the entrance of Beit Ummar in response to alleged stoning.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Fares Abu Mariya and Khader Al-Alamy during their raid into Beit Ummar.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Amur and Ali Al-Amur during their raid into Yatta.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.
